Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

WHEREAS, Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Pahalwan Tannery (Unit-2), '2-A' Gajjupurwa, Jajmau, Kanpur (UP), (here in after referred as 'the Unit') is a tannery engaged in the processing of raw hide to produce finished hides; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued directions dated 10.09.2018 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit to comply with the following:

1. The unit shall resume operation only after obtaining the valid Consent to Operate from UPPCB.
2. The unit shall inform immediately to CPCB, on resumption of manufacturing operations and submit a copy of Consent to Operate to the CPCB.
3. The unit shall submit PETP performance audit report from NPC within 45 days of start of operation.
4. The unit shall maintain log book data of PETP and submit copy to CPCB every month for one year.
5. The Unit shall take necessary action to ensure that primary treated effluent discharged, will always comply the PETP standards prescribed by UPPCB/ inlet to CETP standards and ensure that PETP effluent is treated in the CETP.

AND WHEREAS, Central Pollution Control Board issued Show Cause Notice dated 14.11.2018 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, because unit did not respond to CPCB directions dated 10.09.2018 and not complied with the requirements of the directions, and

WHEREAS, Unit vide letters dated 24.11.2018, 01.01.2019 and 07.02.2019 responded to CPCB directions dated 10.09.2018 and following observations are made:

1. Unit submitted log book of PETP for the month of November'2018, December'2018 and January'2019.
2. Unit mentioned that it could not operate due recent closure of units for Kumbh Mela'2019.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986, Show Cause Notice dated 14.11.2018 is revoked and the unit, **M/s Pahalwan Tannery (Unit-2), '2-A' Gajjupurwa, Jajmau, Kanpur (UP)** is hereby directed to comply with the following directions:

1. The unit shall immediately inform to CPCB on resumption of manufacturing operation.
2. The unit shall comply with CPCB directions dated 10.09.2018 on resumption of operations.
3. The unit shall take necessary action to ensure that primary treated effluent discharged by the unit will always comply the PETP standards prescribed by UPPCB / inlet to CETP standards and ensure that PETP effluent is treated into the CETP.

In case of failure of the unit to comply with the directions, action will be taken in accordance with the provisions under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
