**Sub: Direction under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.**

WHEREAS, the cement industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change has notified emission standards for Particulate matter, SO<sub>2</sub> & NO<sub>x</sub> vide GSR 612 (E) dated 25.08.2014; and amended it vide GSR 496 (E) dated 09.05.2016 for all cement industries and vide GSR 497 (E) dated 10.05.2016 for cement industries carrying out co-processing of wastes in their cement kilns; and

WHEREAS, on request of cement industries, timeline was extended upto March 31, 2017 to comply with the aforesaid new notified emission standards; and

WHEREAS, the matter regarding reconsideration of notified standards was taken up by the cement industries with the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC) and it was decided by MoEF&CC that general extension shall not be granted and any extension regarding compliance shall be based on due assessment and submission of clear/specific road map for compliance with notified standards in a time bound manner. Accordingly, Directions under Section 3 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 have been issued by MoEF&CC to CPCB on 28.03.2017 to ensure implementation of new notified emission standards for cement industries; and

WHEREAS, the cement industries were reminded vide letter dated 30.03.2017 that new notified emission standards for cement industries have become effective from April 01, 2017 and directed to submit clear/specific time-bound action plan for compliance with new notified standards before April 30, 2017; and

WHEREAS, several meetings were convened by Regional Directorates of CPCB with cement industries and State Pollution Control Boards to expedite the submission of action plans and ensure compliance. A standard format was developed to facilitate cement industries in submission of action plans in a precise & scientific manner and the same was circulated among cement industries. Accordingly, all the cement industries were directed to submit the specific action plan as per the standard format before 30.04.2017; and

WHEREAS, as per action plan submitted by M/s ACC Ltd., Jamul Cement Works, Durg, Chhattisgarh, time period upto 30 months was sought by the unit for compliance of new emission standards of cement industries; and


WHEREAS, direction dated 06.09.2017 was issued to M/s ACC Ltd., Jamul Cement Works, Durg, Chhattisgarh, granting time upto 31.08.2018 to comply with the new emission standards and no cement industry was granted time beyond August 31, 2018 for the same; and

WHEREAS, Show Cause Notice (SCN) dated 06.12.2018 was issued to the unit w.r.t. submission of Environmental Compensation at the rate of 30,000/ per day as per Environmental Compensation policy framed in compliance of NGT order dt.31.08.2018 in OA no.593/2017; and

WHEREAS, the unit has submitted replies to SCN vide letter dated 03.01.2019 & 19.12.2018 informing that the unit has achieved compliance of revised norms. (With the delay of 119 days from the time limit i.e. 31.08.2018.) and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof;

Now, THEREFORE, in view of the above and exercising the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, by M/s ACC Ltd., Jamul Cement Works, Durg, Chhattisgarh, is hereby directed to pay Environmental Compensation of Rs 35,70,000/- for non-compliance beyond the time limit i.e.31.08.2018 within 7 days of receipt of this Direction and to submit emission monitoring report from Environment (Protection) Act recognized laboratory on quarterly basis for 1 year. In case of failure, the Board will be constrained to initiate action as deemed necessary and appropriate under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
