Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 – reg.

WHEREAS, the Oil Refineries industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, there is need to inculcate habit of self-monitoring within the industries for complying with the prescribed standards and this can be achieved by the methods like installing online effluent and emission monitoring devices; and

WHEREAS, the M/s Bharat Oman Refineries Ltd., Bina, District Sagar, M.P. (herein after referred as the Unit) has shortlisted for inspection based on No exceedance under OCEMS surveillance programme for the parameters PM & NOx during January 15, to February 15, 2018; and

WHEREAS, Central Pollution Control Board, Regional Directorate, Bhopal inspected the unit from March 26 to March 29, 2018 and observed the following:

1. Emissions discharged from Hot Oil Heater stack w.r.t NOx (548 > 350 mg/ Nm³) and SO₂ (638 > 600 mg/ NM³) at CFBC Boiler-2 stack are exceeding the prescribed norms.
2. The Unit has not provided Hazardous Waste display board with quantity at front gate of storage shed.

WHEREAS, the Unit has not provided online data connectivity for PM parameter at Stack_CPP_Boiler_1; Stack_CPP_Boiler_2 & Stack_CPP_Boiler_3 in emission monitoring system as per the IT Division, CPCB report dated May 11, 2018; and

WHEREAS, based on above stated observations, Directions (notice) under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, was issued to M/s Bharat Oman Refineries Ltd., Bina, District Sagar, Madhya Pradesh on May 18, 2018 to show cause as to why your unit not be directed to close down all operational activities with immediate effect until following directions are compiled:

1. The unit shall upgrade/ maintain the Air Pollution Control System attached to Hot Oil Heater stack and CFBC Boiler-2 stack so that discharged emissions may conform to prescribed standards.
2. The unit shall provide Hazardous Waste display board with quantity at front gate of storage shed.
3. The unit shall provide connectivity for PM parameter at Stack_CPP_Boiler_1; Stack_CPP_Boiler_2 & Stack_CPP_Boiler_3 in emission monitoring system.

WHEREAS, unit has submitted the compliance report vide letter dated June 01, 2018; and

WHEREAS, Unit has provided the connectivity w.r.t PM parameter at stack_ CPP Boiler 1, 2, and 3 as per CPCB, IT Division report dated June 07, 2018; and

WHEREAS, CPCB, RD Bhopal inspected the unit during June 21-22, 2018 to verify the compliance of show cause notice and observed that unit is complying w.r.t show cause notice and all measured values in both stacks are meeting the prescribed standards where found non-compliance in last visit; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and in view of observed compliance with the emission norms by the unit, the directions (notice) issued under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to **M/s Bharat Oman Refineries Ltd., Bina, District Sagar, Madhya Pradesh** vide letter dated May 18, 2018 are hereby revoked.

The Unit shall ensure compliance to the norms. In case of non-compliance observed by the Unit, action as deemed fit under the provisions of Environment (P) Act, 1986 shall be taken.
