**Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986-regarding**

WHEREAS, the Pharmaceutical industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, M/s. Wardex Pharmaceutical Pvt. Ltd., Uttar Pradesh (herein after referred to as the Unit) which comes under pharmaceutical category, has installed Online continuous effluent Monitoring system (OCEMS) for parameters pH, BOD, COD, TSS & Flow; and

WHEREAS, total 846 sms alert received for parameters pH & BOD for the Unit during the month of 15 January- 15 February 2018 for not meeting the prescribed limits; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected by a team of official(s) from the CPCB Regional Directorate, Lucknow on March 19, 2018 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures and online effluent monitoring system, observed as following:

- 1) The Unit has manufacturing the product, the name of which is not mentioned the consent issued from the Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board.
- 2) The Unit has discharging more waste water than the consented limit.
- 3) The Unit has to obtain the permission from the CGWA for the extraction of ground water as mentioned in the consent.
- 4) The pH electrode and COD probe attached in the Online Continuous Effluent Monitoring System (OCEMS) is not working properly.
- 5) The Unit has to remove the filtration unit fixed before the OCEMS.

WHEREAS, on the basis of observations of inspecting team from CPCB Regional Directorate, Lucknow during inspection on March 19, 2018, a direction (Show cause notice) under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 was issued to the Unit vide dated May 09, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Unit informed vide letters dated May 31, 2018 and June 14, 2018 that the Unit has taken corrective action with all the points of show cause notice dated May 09, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was again inspected by a team of official(s) from the CPCB Head office Delhi on June 21, 2018 to assess the compliance status of the Unit: and

WHEREAS, the Unit was found complying w.r.t. show cause notice issued dated May 09, 2018 except that:

- 1) The request for amendment of consent to operate regarding product name and quantity of industrial effluent was pending at Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board (UPPCB);



- 2) The permission from Central ground water authority (CGWA) for extraction of ground water was pending at CGWA; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of powers vested to Chairman CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and in view of compliance with relevant direction under reference, the direction (show cause notice) issued under the Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the Unit (M/s. Wardex Pharmaceutical Pvt. Ltd., Uttar Pradesh) vide letter dated May 09, 2018 is hereby revoked with conditions that:


- i) The Unit shall not extract ground water till the permission is obtained from CGWA for the same,
- ii) The Unit shall limit the treated effluent discharge upto the permitted quantity of UPPCB in consent to operate.
- iii) The unit shall submit the copy of permission letter from CGWA and copy of modified consent to operate from UPPCB within 45 days.

In case of non-compliance by the Unit action as deemed fit under the provisions of Environment (P) Act, 1986 shall be taken.
