DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment, Forest, & Climate Change, Govt. of India, vide notification S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue direction to any industry, Municipal Corporation, Municipal Council, Cantonment Board, to any local or other Authority for the violation of emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and other standards and norms; and

WHEREAS, M/s Faze Three Ltd., Sector 29 GT Road, Panipat, Haryana (*hereafter referred to as 'the Unit'*) is a textile dyeing industry and engaged in the manufacturing of yarn and bathmats; and


WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected by a team of officials from CPCB & Haryana SPCB on 24.05.2018 and made the following observations:

1. The Unit (textile dyeing) & its ETP was operational during the visit.
2. The final ETP treated effluent sample analysis result showed pH-7.69 (*norms-6.5-8.5*); BOD-57 mg/l (*norms-30 mg/l*); COD-231 mg/l (*norms-250 mg/l*); and TSS-21 mg/l (*norms-100 mg/l*) & TDS-1864 mg/l which indicate non-compliance of notified discharge norms w.r.t BOD parameter.
3. The ETP treated effluent was being discharged into the drain.
4. The Unit has agreement with GEPIL for the disposal of their ETP sludge and provided hazardous waste manifest dated 7.4.2016 for the disposal of 6205 kg of hazardous waste by GEPIL.
5. The Unit has provided a freshwater pipeline at the treated water collection tank (feed for tertiary treatment) which should be dismantled as it can be misused to dilute the secondary treated effluent.


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AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, **notice is served herewith to show cause why M/s Faze Three Ltd., Panipat, Haryana should not be closed down** until all the necessary pollution control measures are planned and implemented so as to comply with the prescribed effluent discharge standards to the satisfaction of CPCB.

You are hereby given an opportunity to file your objections (if any) to the above proposed directions within 15 days from the receipt of this notice, failing which it will be presumed that you have nothing to say and appropriate action, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, will be taken against the Unit without giving any further notice.
