Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to M/s Aadit Motors (P) Limited, Panipat, Haryana - Closure thereof.

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from industries under the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986 and rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, holistic approach has been adopted to cover entire Ganga River Basin which cover the states of; Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Delhi, and parts of Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand and West Bengal; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install effluent treatment plants (ETPs) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986 and rules framed there under and also meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs) / Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, M/s Aadit Motors (P) Limited Panipat, Haryana is involved in the process of automobile servicing (Ford Cars);

WHEREAS, in order to verify the compliance status of the industry, a team from Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) carried out an inspection of M/s Aadit Motors (P) Limited Panipat, Haryana on May 15, 2018 and made the following observations:


1. M/s Aadit Motors (P) Limited has a valid consent to operate (CTO) under Air and Water Acts, 1981 & 1974 as well as Hazardous Waste Authorisation valid up to 30.09.2020.
2. The industry was found operational during the inspection, however, **the ETP was found non-operational.**
3. The untreated effluent was found to be discharged on land leading to nearby drain.
4. **The effluent discharge was found to be non-complying with the prescribed standard of TSS: 139 mg/l against the standard of 100 mg/l.**

WHEREAS, Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the non-compliances mentioned above and in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, M/s Aadit Motors (P) Limited Panipat, Haryana is hereby directed to close down its operations with immediate effect and shall not resume its operation without ensuring regular operation of ETP.




