DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, the Textile industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting Industries /Red category which have been discharging effluents directly or indirectly on land and into water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on land and the ambient water quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install and operate Effluent Treatment plant (ETP) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the Rules framed thereunder and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCB)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment, Forest, & Climate Change, Govt. of India, vide notification S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue direction to any industry, Municipal Corporation, Municipal Council, Cantonment Board, to any local or other Authority for the violation of emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and other standards and norms; and

WHEREAS, M/s Home Trends, Panipat, Haryana (*hereafter referred to as 'the Unit'*) is a Yarn/Textile processing industry involving bleaching, Dyeing, Printing & colouring; and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected by a joint team of officials from CPCB & Haryana SPCB on 16.05.2018 and found closed. The joint team revisited the unit on 22.05.2018 to verify the compliance status and made following observations:

1. The Unit has consented capacity of 4.0TPD (mink blanket) and present production is 2.5 - 3 TPD. The unit & its ETP were found in operation.
2. The Unit consent is valid up to 30.09.2022 under Air & Water Act and valid. The Authorization under HW Rule was not available.
3. The ETP comprises of Equalization tank, Flocculator, Tube Settler Dual Media Filter, Ion Exchange Column, & Chlorination. The Unit discharge its final treated effluent into local drain.
4. The final ETP treated effluent analysis result showed pH-7.43 (*norms-6.5-8.5*), TSS-91mg/l (*norms-100*), BOD-251mg/l (*norms-30*), COD-658mg/l (*norms-250*), O&G-06mg/l (*norms-10*) & TDS-1304 mg/l (*norms-2100*) which indicates **non-compliance** with BOD & COD discharge norms.

Closure direction u/s 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to M/s Home Trends, Panipat, Haryana

It is evident from the above, the unit is non-complying with BOD & COD discharge standards notified under E(P) Rules, 1986 and posing a grave injury to the surface water/river water quality and environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the **following directions are issued for compliance to M/s Home Trends, Panipat, Haryana:**

1. The Unit shall immediately close down all the manufacturing operations and shall report to CPCB regarding closure of manufacturing operations immediately on receipt of this direction.
2. The Unit should carry out adequacy assessment of ETP through reputed Institute/organisations such as IIT/NIT/NEERI & accordingly upgrade its ETP so as to meet prescribed standard.
3. The Unit shall obtain Authorization under Hazardous Waste Rule 2016 and provide arrangement for disposal of hazardous waste in scientific manner.
4. The Unit shall seek permission from CPCB before resumption of the manufacturing operation.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the Unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
