Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, Pharmaceutical units are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed thereunder; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install and operate Effluent Treatment plant (ETP) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the Rules framed thereunder and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCB)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the matter of Paryavaran Suraksha Samiti Vs Union of India & Others dated 22/02/2017 directed that no industry which requires "consent to operate" from the concerned Pollution Control Board, is permitted to function, unless it has a functional effluent treatment plant, which is capable to meet the prescribed norms for removing the pollutants from the effluent, before it is discharged; and

WHEREAS, a team of officers from the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), Delhi on inspected **M/s Laborate Pharmaceutical India Pvt. Ltd. T-11, Industrial Area, Panipat, Haryana** (herein after referred as the Unit) on May 22, 2018 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures; and

WHEREAS, the inspecting team found the Unit operational and observed the following:

1. During visit, it has been observed that they are not operating ETP properly.
2. The industry is manufacturing Tablets, Capsules and Ointments.
3. The industry is using Tube well for meeting the request of water for domestic as well as industry purpose.
4. It has been observed from the analysis result that the parameter **BOD: 1183 mg/l (against the norms of 30 mg/l), Oil & Grease: 13 mg/l (against the norms of 30 mg/l) and TSS: 208 mg/l (against the norms of 100 mg/l)** are exceeding the limit.

5. The unit has not obtained valid consent to operate under Air and Water Act from HPCB.


It is evident from the above observations that the Unit is violating the prescribed effluent discharge standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986, and the discharge of untreated/partially treated effluent has all possibility to adverse impact the river water quality.

AND WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the following directions are being issued to the unit **M/s Laborate Pharmaceutical India Pvt. Ltd. T-11, Industrial Area, Panipat, Haryana:**

1. The Unit shall close all the plant operations with immediate effect and inform CPCB.
2. The Unit shall install adequate Effluent Treatment Plant and operate it properly so as to achieve prescribed standards for effluent discharge.
3. The unit shall obtain valid consent to operate from Haryana Pollution Control Board
4. The Unit shall obtain permission from the Central Pollution Control Board before the resumption of plant operations.


