**DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986**

**WHEREAS**, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of emission and effluent standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install effluent treatment plants (ETPs) to comply with the effluent discharged standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCBs)/Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

**WHEREAS**, Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the matter of Paryavaran Suraksha Samiti Vs Union of India & Others dated 22/02/2017 directed that no industry which requires "consent to operate" from the concerned Pollution Control Board, is permitted to function, unless it has a functional effluent treatment plant, which is capable to meet the prescribed norms for removing the pollutants from the effluent, before it is discharged; and

**WHEREAS**, Ms/ Harisons Automobiles, GT Road, Gohana Road, Panipat, Haryana (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is involved in sales and running workshop of M/s Maruti Suzuki); and

**WHEREAS**, the Unit was inspected by team deputed by CPCB and Haryana State Pollution Control Board officials on 30.05.2018 with respect to effluent discharge in Yamuna river at Panipat and made the observations as mentioned thereafter:

1. The unit was operational (Car washing and servicing of vehicles) at the time of inspection
2. ETP was not operating. It was observed that since a long time, ETP was not operated.
3. Underground storage tank in septic condition.
4. No log book for hazardous waste has been maintained.
5. The validity of Air and Water consent and authorization of Hazardous waste(HW) has expired in March 2017.
6. The plant has not applied for the renewal application for the consent of Air and Water and authorization of HW.
7. Waste water generated due to washing of cars was directly discharged into sewer line without treating in ETP.
8. Samples is not collected during the inspection as waste water generated due to washing of cars was directly discharged into sewer line without treating in ETP.

**It is evident from the above observations that the Unit has been in operation for more than one year without valid air & water consents under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1981 and authorization under Hazardous**

**and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Amendment Rules, 2016 and the discharge of untreated effluent has all possibility to adverse impact the river water quality.**

**NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the following directions are being issued to the unit **Ms/ Harisons Automobiles, GT Road, Gohana Road, Panipat, Haryana:**

1. The Unit shall close all wet operations with immediate effect and inform CPCB.
2. The Unit shall install adequate Effluent Treatment Plant and operate it properly so as to achieve prescribed standards for effluent discharge.
3. The unit shall obtain consent to operate under Water & Air Acts from Haryana State Pollution Control Board.
4. The unit shall obtain authorisation under Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Amendment Rules, 2016.
5. After completion of the above said measures, the Unit shall report to CPCB and seek permission from CPCB before resumption of their manufacturing operations.


