Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, Textile dyeing and bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified general discharge standards of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under;and

WHEREAS, Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the matter of Paryavaran Suraksha Samiti Vs Union of India & Others dated 22/02/2017 directed that no industry which requires "consent to operate" from the concerned Pollution Control Board, is permitted to function, unless it has a functional effluent treatment plant, which is capable to meet the prescribed norms for removing the pollutants from the effluent, before it is discharged; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Capital Woollen & General Mills, H-62, Industrial Area, Panipat, Haryana (here in after referred as 'the unit') is a textile processing unit; and

AND WHEREAS, the unit was inspected on 24th May, 2018 by CPCB officials and following observations are made:

- 1) The unit was found operational at the time of inspection.
- 2) The unit has air, water and hazardous waste consents valid upto 31st March,2021.
- 3) The ETP sludge is sent to Gujrat Enviro Protection and Infrastructure Pvt. Ltd.
- 4) The analysis of the samples taken at the outlet of ETP showed the following results: pH – 7.31 (against stipulated standards of 6-5-8.5), TSS- 72 mg/l (against stipulated standards of 100 mg/l), **BOD -115 mg/l** (against stipulated standards of 30 mg/l), **COD-318 mg/l** (against stipulated standards of 250 mg/l), Colour-43 PCU (against stipulated standards of 150 PCU), TDS- 2280 mg/l (against stipulated standards of 2100

mg/l), SAR- 1.41 (against stipulated standards of 26), Oil & Grease -4 mg/l (against stipulated standards of 10 mg/l), Phenol -0.13 mg/l (against stipulated standards of 1.0 mg/l), Ammonical Nitrogen -15 mg/l (against stipulated standards of 50 mg/l) and Chromium -0.15 mg/l (against stipulated standards of 2 mg/l) which show non-compliance w.r.t. TDS, BOD and COD.

It is evident from above observations that the unit is discharging partially treated/ untreated effluent into the drain, thereby posing serious threat to the surface and groundwater quality.

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit, **M/s Capital Woollen & General Mills, H-62, Industrial Area, Panipat, Haryana** is hereby served notice to Show Cause why the unit should not be closed down for non-compliance of stipulated standards.

You are hereby given an opportunity to file your objections (if any) to the above directions within 30 days of receipt of these directions, failing which appropriate action will be taken against the unit without any further notice, in accordance with the provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
