Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986- reg.

WHEREAS, Central Government has notified standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under Rule 3 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications no. S.O. 157(E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install effluent treatment plants (ETPs) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCBs) / Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued directions dated 21st June, 2016 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to **M/s. N.R Silk International LLP 2/12 A, Angoori Bagh, Farrukhabad, UP** (hereinafter referred to as 'the Unit') for installing online effluent monitoring system;

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected on 28th March, 2017 by a team of CPCB/CPCPI officials for compliance verification of Ganga GPI units; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure directions dated 30th May, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 directing that the unit shall close down all its manufacturing operations and not restart manufacturing till it complies with the following directions:

1. The unit shall operate as per terms and condition of the water consent obtained from the UPPCB which is valid till 31st December, 2019.
2. The Unit shall install required online continuous effluent / emission monitoring system (OCEMS) at the outlet / discharge points.
3. The unit shall obtain permission from CGWA for extraction of ground water and install water meter at the intake point of tube wells.
4. The analysis results of the samples taken from the ETP of the unit were found meeting the prescribed standards. However, the unit shall remove light brownish colour from the treated water before discharging into drain or recycle in the process.
5. The unit shall renew the agreement with Bharat Oil for treatment and disposal of oil and sludge which was expired on 23 May, 2017.
6. The unit shall obtain valid registration under the H.W (M. H & T. M) Rules, 2008.

AND WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letters dated 20th June, 2017 and 24th May, 2018 were examined and following observations are made:

- 1) The unit has installed OCEMS and connected it with CPCB server.
- 2) The unit has also submitted water consent with validity upto 31st December, 2019.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27th September, 2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF & CC & NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 12th July, 2018 examined the unit's replies dated 24th May, 2018 and 20th June, 2017 and recommended the unit to resume operation;

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit, **M/s. N.R Silk International LLP 2/12 A, Angoori Bagh, Farrukhabad, (U.P.)** is hereby issued directions as follows:

- 1) The unit shall resume operation and inform to CPCB about date of resumption of operation.
- 2) The unit shall ensure regular connectivity of its OCEMS with CPCB server and shall comply with stipulated standards of CPCB.
- 3) The unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to CPCB within 30 days of resumption of operation.

In case of non-compliance of the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate action against the unit without giving any further notice in accordance with the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
