DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install and operate Effluent Treatment plant (ETP) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the Rules framed there under and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCB)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment, Forest, & Climate Change, Govt. of India, vide notification S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue direction to any industry, Municipal Corporation, Municipal Council, Cantonment Board, to any local or other Authority for the violation of emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and other standards and norms; and

WHEREAS, **M/s Sarv India Home Furnishing**, Sanoli Road, 11 Km stone Near Krishna Gaushala, Near Kurar Town, VPO-Jalalpur, Panipat, Haryana (*hereafter referred to as 'the Unit'*) is engaged in manufacturing of Mink blanket using Polyester Yarn Dyes and Chemicals. The consented production capacity is 10 T/day. The Unit was operational during the visit; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected by a team of officials from CPCB & Haryana SPCB on 16.05.2018 and made following observations:

1. The Unit is engaged in the manufacturing of Mink blanket using Polyester Yarn, Dyes and Chemicals. The consented production capacity is 10 T/day.
2. ETP was found operational at the time of inspection.
3. The final ETP treated effluent sample analysis result showed pH-6.85 (*norms-6.0-8.5*); BOD-230 mg/l (*norms-30 mg/l*); COD-820 mg/l (*norms-250 mg/l*), TSS-178 mg/l (*norms-100 mg/l*) and Oil & Grease- 108 mg/l (*norms-10 mg/l*) which indicate non-compliance of notified discharge norms w.r.t BOD, COD, TSS and Oil & Grease parameter.
4. As per the consent order, the unit is not permitted to discharge any effluent and the treated effluent is recycled and reused in boiler and process.

However the analysis report indicate that the treated effluent quality is not adequate to be reused in process/boiler and that the ETP provided by the unit is not functioning properly to treat the effluent to the required quality for recycle/reuse and to maintain the ZLD condition imposed by HSPCB

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the **following directions are issued for compliance to M/s Sarv India Home Furnishing**, Sanoli Road, 11 Km stone Near Krishna Gaushala, Near Kurar Town, VPO-Jalalpur, Panipat, Haryana, Haryana:

1. The unit shall immediately close down all the manufacturing operations and shall report to CPCB regarding closure of manufacturing operations in compliance of the closure direction immediately on receipt of this direction.
2. The unit shall carry out adequacy assessment of ETP through reputed organisation/institute preferably IIT/NIT/NEERI & accordingly upgrade its ETP so as to meet the required quality for being reused/recycled entirely, to meet the ZLD condition imposed by HSPCB.
3. The Unit shall provide separate energy meter for ETP operation & shall maintain logbook as per the consent condition.
4. The Unit shall seek permission from CPCB before resumption of the manufacturing operation.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the Unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
