DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, the Textile industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting /Red category Industries which have been discharging effluents directly or indirectly on land and into water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on land and the ambient water quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install and operate Effluent Treatment plant (ETP) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the Rules framed thereunder and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCB)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment, Forest, & Climate Change, Govt. of India, vide notification S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue direction to any industry, Municipal Corporation, Municipal Council, Cantonment Board, to any local or other Authority for the violation of emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and other standards and norms; and

WHEREAS, M/s Gold Spin India Pvt. Ltd., Industrial Area, Panipat, Haryana (*hereafter referred to as 'the Unit'*) is a textile - dying & Printing industry and; and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected by a team of officials from CPCB & Haryana SPCB on 16.05.2018 to verify the compliance status and made following observations:

1. The Unit is textile industry having installed capacity of 06TPD and manufacturing polar blanket. Present production of the unit is 04 TPD. During inspection, the unit & its ETP were found in operation.
2. The Unit consent is valid upto 30.09.2020 under Air & Water Act and Authorisation under HW Rule is valid upto 30.09.2020.
3. As per the Consent issued by Haryana SPCB, the unit is permitted to discharge 10 KLD industrial effluent & 01 KLD domestic effluent.
4. The ETP comprises of Chemical tank, Equalization tank, clarifier, Tube Settler, Flash mixer, SBF, ACF, sludge drying bed and treated water tank. The Unit discharges final treated effluent into local drain.

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Closure direction under section 5 of the E(P)Act, 1986 to M/s Gold Spin India Pvt. Ltd., Panipat, Haryana

5. The final ETP treated effluent sample results showed pH-7.78 (*norms-6.5-8.5*), TSS-25 mg/l (*norms-100*), **BOD-112mg/l** (*norms-30*), **COD-431mg/l** (*norms-250*), O&G-BDL mg/l (*norms-10*) & TDS-528 mg/l (*norms-2100*) which indicates **non-compliance** w.r.t BOD & COD discharge norms.
6. The Unit has agreement with Gujarat Enviro Protection & Infrastructure (Haryana) Ltd (GEPIL) for Hazardous Waste disposal.

It is evident form the above, the unit is non-complying w.r.t BOD & COD discharge norms notified under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and posing a grave injury to the surface water /river water quality and environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the **following directions are issued for compliance to M/s Gold Spin India Pvt. Ltd.**, Panipat, Haryana:

1. The Unit shall immediately close down all the manufacturing operations and shall report to CPCB regarding closure of manufacturing operations immediately on receipt of this closure direction.
2. The Unit should carry out adequacy assessment of ETP through reputed Institute/organisation preferably IIT/NIT/NEERI & accordingly upgrade/augment its ETP so as to meet prescribed standard.
3. The Unit shall maintain log book of water consumption and waste water generation & discharge.
4. The Unit shall seek permission from CPCB before resumption of the manufacturing operation.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the Unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
