Sub.: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 –reg.

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed thereunder; and

WHEREAS, Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the matter of Paryavaran Suraksha Samiti Vs Union of India & Others dated 22/02/2017 directed that no industry which requires "consent to operate" from the concerned Pollution Control Board, is permitted to function, unless it has a functional effluent treatment plant, which is capable to meet the prescribed norms for removing the pollutants from the effluent, before it is discharged; and

WHEREAS, a team of officers from the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), Delhi inspected M/s Paruthi Engineers Pvt. Ltd. (unit-II), Sonapat, Haryana (herein after referred as the Unit) on May 16, 2018 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures; and

WHEREAS, the inspecting team found that the Unit was operational and observed the following:

1. The treated effluent is being collected in collection pit and is reused in industry premises.
2. The analysis results of treated effluent indicates that it is exceeding the prescribed limits of the consent w.r.t parameters pH (3.98 < 6), TSS (253 mg/l > 100mg/l), Iron(216.9mg/l > 3mg/l), Lead(0.79mg/l > 0.1mg/l), Zinc(63.64mg/l > 5mg/l).

WHEREAS, in view of the above, closure direction issued to M/s Paruthi Engineers Pvt. Ltd. (unit-II), Sonapat, Haryana vide letter dated July 24, 2018 and directed to close down all manufacturing / production activity until compliance of the following directions is achieved;

1. The Unit shall close all the plant operations with immediate effect.
2. The Unit shall operate Effluent Treatment Plant properly so as to achieve the prescribed standards for effluent discharge.
3. The unit shall comply with the conditions prescribed in the consent issued by Haryana State Pollution Control Board.
4. The unit shall not resume its operation without compliance to above directions and prior permission of CPCB.

WHEREAS, unit replied vide letter dated August 10, 2018 that the operations has been closed down w.e.f. August 09, 2018 as per CPCB direction and requested to revoke the closure direction; and

WHEREAS, unit has submitted the undertaking for compliance on stamp paper, valid CTO up to September 30, 2021 and third party analysis reports from MoEF&CC recognized lab M/s Haryana Test House; and

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 03.10.2017 having representative(s) from CPCB and MoEF&CC for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the unit has submitted adequacy report of ETP vide letter dated August 20, 2018 from Deenabandhu Chotu Ram University as per directed by Three-member committee in its meeting held on 13.08.2018; and

WHEREAS, the Three-member committee in its meeting held on 23.08.2018 examined the compliance report submitted by the Unit and recommended for revocation of closure with condition that the unit will submit the performance audit report of ETP from government expert Institution within 60 days of start of operation; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.


NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and in view of the compliance of above directions and the affidavit produced by the unit, the directions issued under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to **M/s Paruthi Engineers Pvt. Ltd. (unit-II), Sonapat, Haryana** vide letter dated July 24, 2018 is hereby revoked.

In case of non-compliance by the unit, action as deemed fit under the provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 shall be taken.
