Sub.: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 regarding installation of on-line effluent and emission monitoring system-Show cause Notice

WHEREAS, the Pharmaceutical industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, it was observed by the IT division of the CPCB that the OCEMS of the Unit M/s. Eisai Pharmaceuticals India Pvt. Ltd., Andhra Pradesh (herein after referred to as the Unit) was in offline mode during 15 May-15 June 2018, and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected by a team of official(s) from the CPCB Regional Directorate, Bangalore on July 19, 2018 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures and online effluent monitoring system, observed as following:



- The treated effluent analysis results show that the parameter pH (5.5 < 6.5-8.5) exceeds the APPCB standards.
- The web camera is not placed at proper location.
- The Unit has not provided the flow meter and web camera for HTDS effluent.

WHEREAS, the online data connectivity has been verified from IT division and it was observed by the IT division dated August 13, 2018 that the Unit has provided the flow meter connectivity only for the LTDS effluent and web camera view was not available at the time of data verification; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, a notice is hereby served to the Unit (M/s. Eisai Pharmaceuticals India Pvt. Ltd., Andhra Pradesh) to show cause why the Unit should not be closed down as the Unit is not complying with respect to the above mentioned observations of the inspecting team.

The compliance of above direction (notice) shall be submitted to this office within 30 days of the receipt of the directions. In case of failure to comply with the said directions necessary action as deemed fit under the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 will be taken by CPCB.
