**Sub.: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 regarding installation of on-line effluent and emission monitoring system-Show cause Notice**

WHEREAS, the Pharmaceutical industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, M/s. SVR Laboratories (P) Ltd., Telangana (herein after referred to as the Unit) which comes under pharmaceutical category, has installed online flow meter and web camera as the Online continuous effluent Monitoring system (OCEMS) as it is sending effluent to common effluent treatment plant (CETP); and

WHEREAS, it was observed by the IT division of the CPCB that the Online continuous effluent Monitoring system (OCEMS) of the Unit was in offline mode during the month of 15 February-15 March 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected by a team of official(s) from the CPCB Regional Directorate, Bangalore on April 24, 2018 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures and online effluent monitoring system, observed as following:

- The Unit is not segregating the HTDS & LTDS effluents and the Unit has not provided the separate collection tank of the storage of the LTDS effluent.
- The Unit is not providing the proper camera coverage for outlet flow meter for HTDS and LTDS collection tanks.
- The Unit is not adhering to the Telangana SPCB consent condition of regularly sending the HTDS & LTDS effluents to CETP.
- The Unit is regularly using the stand by in-house ZLD facility to treat unsegregated effluents.
- The Unit is not providing the proper maintenance to in-house ZLD facility as the seals of the all feed pumps were worn and leakage of the effluent was observed.
- The Unit is not maintaining the records of the disposal of effluent to CETP.
- The housekeeping of the Unit is poor w.r.t storage of the solid residue/salt storage inside the ETP.

WHEREAS, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the Unit vide letter dated May 22, 2018 based on the observations of the inspecting team; and

WHEREAS, the Unit informed through email dated June 18, 2018 that the Unit has taken corrective action with all the points of show cause notice dated May 22, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the CPCB requested the RD, Bengaluru vide letter dated June 20, 2018 to verify the compliance of the direction submitted by the Unit against Show cause notice issued to the Unit; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was again inspected by a team of official(s) from the RD, Bangalore on July 13, 2018 to assess the compliance status of the Unit and the Unit was found complying w.r.t. show cause notice issued dated March 22, 2018 except the web camera connectivity of the facing the LTDS flow meter; and

WHEREAS, the OCEMS online data connectivity of the Unit has been verified by the IT division vide report dated August 23, 2018 and the Units was found connected with CPCB for two flow meters and two web cameras facing HTDS & LTDS flow meters; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of powers vested to Chairman CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and in view of compliance with relevant direction under reference, the direction (show cause notice) issued under the Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the Unit (M/s. SVR Laboratories (P) Ltd., Telangana) vide letter dated May 22, 2018 is hereby revoked. In case of non-compliance by the Unit action as deemed fit under the provisions of Environment (P) Act, 1986 shall be taken.


