DIRECTIONS UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, the Textile, dyeing and bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the general discharge standards of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under;

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Shiva Knitwear, B-15, 16, Site-4, Panki Industrial area, Kanpur (here in after referred as 'the unit') is a textile processing unit;

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected on 7th April, 2017 and 10th May, 2017 to verify the compliance status; and

WHEREAS, the unit was issued closure directions dated 15th May, 2017 for non-installation of OCEMS; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure directions dated 27th June, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; and

WHEREAS, the unit was re-inspected on 20th June, 2017 to verify the compliance status and was found operational at the time of inspection, in violation of closure directions dated 15th May, 2017; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure directions dated 6th November, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for compliance of the following directions:

- 1) The unit shall remain closed and not operate/ start manufacturing without permission of CPCB.
- 2) The unit shall ensure proper operation and maintenance of its ETP.
- 3) The unit shall comply with CPCB directions dated 15th May, 2017 and 27th June, 2017 issued under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

4) The unit shall seek permission from CPCB before resumption of operation.

AND WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letters dated 27th July, 2017, 8th September, 2017, 21st November, 2017, 4th December, 2017 and 9th December, 2017 were examined and following observations are made:

- 1) The unit has provided online connectivity of flow meter with CPCB server.
- 2) The unit has applied for air and water consent with reduced discharge capacity of 8 KLD and 0.5 KLD for domestic discharge.
- 3) The unit has provided plan of modified ETP as well as photographs.
- 4) The unit has applied for NOC for groundwater abstraction to CGWA and applied for hazardous waste authorization to UPPCB.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27th September, 2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF & CC & NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 27th February, 2018 examined the replies dated 27th July, 2017, 8th September, 2017, 21st November, 2017, 4th December, 2017 and 9th December, 2017 and recommended that:

- 1) The unit is recommended for resuming the operation **for one month only to assess the performance of ETP inspection by CPCB/authorized agency**. The final assessment report shall be placed before the committee.

AND WHEREAS, in response to the revoke direction issued to the Unit on 26.03.2018, the Unit has informed CPCB about **resumption of operation of the Unit from 20.04.2018** vide its letter dated 19.04.2018; and

WHEREAS, in pursuance of revoke direction issued to the Unit, team from Regional Directorate, Lucknow has inspected the Unit on **03.07.2018** to verify the compliance of the Unit as per conditional revoke issued to the Unit dated 26.03.2018; and

WHEREAS, inspecting team has made the following observations:

1. The Unit was found operational on the day of inspection by R.D., Lucknow team.
2. The consent to operate under Water Act of the Unit has expired on 31.12.2017, no consent to operate under Air act was available.
3. The Unit has **applied** for consent under Air act and under Water act with a reduced discharge capacity of 08 KLD, NOC from CGWA and hazardous waste authorization from UPPCB.
4. No proper logbook was found maintained for flowmeters at tube wells, outlet of ETP and sludge generation and disposal.
5. The analysis results of treated effluent samples revealed that the Unit is **complying** with all parameters of effluent discharge standards.

AND WHEREAS, as per the conditional revoke direction issued to the Unit, the compliance verification report submitted by Regional Directorate, Lucknow of CPCB was considered by the three Member Expert Committee in its meeting held on 23.08.2018 and has recommended the following:

"In view of CPCB inspection to verify the ETP performance, dated 26.07.2018 the Unit may be allowed to resume operation subject to submission of log book data of ETP for each month upto 01 year."

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit, **M/s Shiva Knitwear, B-15, 16, Site-4, Panki Industrial area, Kanpur** is hereby directed to comply with following directions:

1. The Unit may resume manufacturing operations only after obtaining valid consent to operate under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 from UPPCB with a reduced discharge capacity as per application submitted.
2. The Unit shall immediately inform to CPCB regarding the date of resumption of operations along with copies of necessary permissions and Consents.
3. The Unit will submit logbook data of ETP to CPCB and SPCB for each month upto 01 year from the date of resumption of operations
4. The Unit shall operate ETP properly so as to ensure with the effluent discharge norms notified under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
5. The Unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report, to CPCB within 4 days from the date of resumption of operations, from a laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
6. The Unit shall ensure continuous data connectivity of OCEMS system installed at the outlet of ETP with CPCB server.

In case of non-compliance of the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate action against the unit without giving any further notice in accordance with the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
