Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986- reg.

WHEREAS, Central Government has notified standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under Rule 3 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications no. S.O. 157(E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install effluent treatment plants (ETPs) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCBs) / Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, the unit, M/s. Neman Carpet (Formerly H.A.G. Carpet Industry), C-3&4, Industrial Estate, Mirzapur-231301, UP was inspected on 21st March, 2017 by a team of CPCB/CPCPI officials for compliance verification of Ganga GPI units; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure directions dated 26th April, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 directing that the unit shall close down all its manufacturing operations and not restart manufacturing for non-compliance of stipulated standards and non-installation of OCEMS.

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure directions dated 15th May, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for compliance of the following directions:

- 1) The unit shall stop all wet process operations immediately till installation and commissioning of online continuous effluent monitoring system (OCEMS) and provide connectivity to the CPCB server for continuous 24 X7 data transmission.
- 2) The unit shall report to CPCB about stopping of wet process operations immediately. The unit shall seek permission from CPCB before resumption of wet process operation

AND WHEREAS, the unit was re-inspected by CPCB on 22nd June, 2017 and was found closed in compliance with CPCB directions; and

WHEREAS, the unit was re-inspected on 15th May, 2018 and the following observations were made:

- 1) The unit was found non-operational at the time of inspection.
- 2) As per the unit representative, the unit is non-operational since 13th June, 2017 and all its property has been sold to another carpet industry namely M/s Neman Carpet (Dyeing Division).
- 3) The industrial machinery and equipment's boiler were found in good condition.
- 4) The upgradation of ETP was under process such as installation of tertiary treatment system and OCEMS.

AND WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letters dated 3rd July, 2018, 23rd July, 2018 and 14th August, 2018 were examined and following observations are made:

- 1) The unit has installed OCEMS and connected it with CPCB server.
- 2) The unit has also submitted the details of the newly installed ETP.
- 3) The unit has applied for both Air and Water consents dated 2nd August, 2018.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27th September, 2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF & CC & NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 23rd August, 2018 examined the unit's replies dated 3rd July, 2018, 23rd July, 2018 and 14th August, 2018 and recommended the following:

- 1) Performance audit report of ETP by reputed government institute to be submitted within 60 days of resumption of operation.
- 2) The unit shall obtain valid consent to operate (CTO) from UPPCB before resuming operation.
- 3) The performance audit report is to be put up to the committee after examination by CPCB for approval.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit, **M/s. Neman Carpet (Formerly H.A.G. Carpet Industry), C-3&4, Industrial Estate, Mirzapur-231301, UP** is hereby directed to comply with following directions:

- 1) The unit shall resume operation only after obtaining valid consent from UPPCB and inform to CPCB about date of resumption of operation.
- 2) The unit shall ensure regular OCEMS data connectivity with CPCB server and shall comply with stipulated discharge standards.
- 3) The unit shall submit performance audit report of ETP by reputed government institute within 60 days from resumption of operation.

In case of non-compliance of the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate action against the unit without giving any further notice in accordance with the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
