Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 - reg.

WHEREAS, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Pahalwan Tannery (Unit-II), 2-A, Gajjapurwa, Jajmau, Kanpur, UP (hereafter referred as the Unit), is a tannery engaged in processing of raw hides to produce finished leather by Chrome tanning; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued Closure direction dated 29.08.2017 under Sec-5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit; and

WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letter dated 18.09.2017, 17.11.2017, 19.01.2018, 10.04.2018 & 20.07.2018 were examined and following observation are made:

- (i) The unit's Consent to operate has expired on 31.12.2017.
- (ii) The unit has submitted Authorization valid up to 05.01.2022; issued under the provisions of Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management and Trans-boundary movement) Rules 2016.
- (iii) The unit has submitted Self-certificate & Affidavit in prescribed format.
- (iv) The unit has submitted the PETP adequacy assessment report, prepared by NPC Kanpur and PETP reported to be adequate.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF&CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, Three Member Committee in meeting held on 23.08.2018 examined the replies and recommended for revoke of closure direction with the following conditions:

- (i) The unit shall submit PETP performance audit report from NPC within 45 days of start of operation.
- (ii) The unit shall obtain the valid consent to operate from UPPCB and submit a copy to the CPCB
- (iii) The unit shall maintain log book data of PETP and be submitted to CPCB every month for one year.

AND NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the closure direction dated 29.08.2017 is hereby revoked and the unit **M/s Pahalwan Tannery (Unit-II), 2-A, Gajipurwa, Jajmau, Kanpur, UP** is directed to comply with the following:

- (i) The unit shall resume operation only after obtaining the valid Consent to Operate from UPPCB.
- (ii) The unit shall inform immediately to CPCB, on resumption of manufacturing operations and submit a copy of Consent to Operate to the CPCB.
- (iii) The unit shall submit PETP performance audit report from NPC within 45 days of start of operation.
- (iv) The unit shall maintain log book data of PETP and submit copy to CPCB every month for one year.
- (v) The Unit shall take necessary action to ensure that primary treated effluent discharged, will always comply the PETP standards prescribed by UPPCB / inlet to CETP standards and ensure that PETP effluent is treated in the CETP.

In case of failure of compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
