**Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 –reg.**

WHEREAS, Fertilizer units are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality;

WHEREAS, a direction under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 was issued on February 05, 2014 to all the State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs) for installation of online emission monitoring system w.r.t. Urea Plants – PM, CAN/NPK/Ammonium Nitrite – PM, Ammonia, Fluoride, DAP plants – PM, Fluoride & SSP plants – PM, Fluoride parameters & online effluent monitoring system w.r.t. pH, Ammonical Nitrogen, Fluoride & Flow parameters in Fertilizer industries; and

WHEREAS, it was clarified that flow meter & web camera may be installed in case of Units with zero liquid discharge (ZLD) by March 31, 2015 vide guidelines uploaded on website of CPCB dated November 7, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS on the basis of SMS alerts generated by online monitoring system at the unit during the period from February 15, 2018 to March 15, 2018, a team of officers from the Regional Directorate, Central Pollution Control Board, Bhopal visited the unit **M/s R C Fertilizers, Plot No. F-96/97, RIICO Industrial Area, Gudli, Tehsil- Mavli, Udaipur, Rajasthan** on April 16, 2018 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures; and

WHEREAS, based on the observations of above stated inspection, directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, were issued to the unit on 16.05.2018 to close all manufacturing / production activity until it complies with the following directions:

1. The Unit shall take necessary steps so that concentration of fluoride in emission complies with prescribed norms.

2. The unit shall ensure proper storage of silica sludge.
3. The unit shall make internal roads paved to prevent fugitive emissions. The unit shall take necessary steps to control fugitive emissions at process areas, raw material storage and handling area. All the raw materials and finished product shall be stored under covered area to prevent fugitive emissions.
4. The unit shall provide connectivity of online continuous emission monitoring system to CPCB for Fluoride parameter at stack of SSP plant and for PM parameter at stack of GSSP plant.
5. The unit shall provide connectivity of online continuous effluent monitoring system to CPCB for flow meter and web camera (PTZ).
6. The unit shall obtain valid Consent to operate under Water act, 1974 and Air act, 1981 of the SSP Plant from Rajasthan State Pollution Control Board.

WHEREAS, the Unit provided online connectivity of flow meter, web camera, HF (Fluoride) and PM parameters to CPCB as per IT Division, CPCB report dated June 18, 2018 ; and

WHEREAS, the Unit submitted a notarised undertaking dated July 10, 2018 that the Unit has complied with directions no. 01, 04 & 05 out of 06 directions issued by CPCB and unit has requested for 3 months' time for achieving the full compliance ; and

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 03.10.2017 having representative(s) from CPCB and MoEF&CC for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the case of the unit was put up before revocation committee on July 27, 2018 and it was observed that the documentary evidence of the actions taken in respect of CPCB Directions no. 2 & 3 has not been provided by the unit and hence revocation was not recommended by the committee ; and

WHEREAS, the unit (M/s R C Fertilizers, Plot No. F-96/97, RIICO Industrial Area, Gudli, Tehsil- Mavli, Udaipur, Rajasthan) submitted documentary evidence vide letter dated 10.08.2018 wherein unit mentioned that it has started work regarding compliance of point no. 02 and 03 of CPCB directions and requested for 03 months' time for achieving complete compliance.

WHEREAS, the case of the unit was again put up before revocation committee on 29.08.2018 wherein it was recommended that revocation directions may be issued to the Unit subject to the following conditions:

1. The unit shall obtain valid Consent to Operate from Rajasthan State Pollution Control Board.
2. The unit shall get the performance audit of Emission Control System and Effluent Treatment Plant conducted by an expert Government Institute on half yearly basis and shall submit the performance audit reports to Central Pollution Control Board.

WHEREAS the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested to chairman CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the directions issued under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the Unit (M/s R C Fertilizers, Plot No. F-96/97, RIICO Industrial Area, Gudli, Tehsil- Mavli, Udaipur, Rajasthan) vide letter dated May 16, 2018 is hereby revoked with following conditions:

1. The unit shall obtain valid Consent to Operate from Rajasthan State Pollution Control Board.
2. The unit shall get the performance audit of Emission Control System and Effluent Treatment Plant conducted by an expert Government Institute on half yearly basis and shall submit the performance audit reports to Central Pollution Control Board.

The Unit shall ensure compliance to the norms. In case of non-compliance observed by the Unit, action as deemed fit under the provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 shall be taken.
