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Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 –reg.

WHEREAS, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, there is need to inculcate habit of self monitoring within the industries for complying with the prescribed standards and this can be achieved by the methods like installing online effluent & emission monitoring devices, mechanical system for chemical dosing and sludge dewatering to avoid human errors and get the consistent results; and

WHEREAS, M/s Jama Corporation Pvt. Ltd., Vill- Khalipur, Teh- Akbarpur, Kanpur Dehat (U.P)-209311 (here in after referred as 'the Unit') is involved in the processing of Wet Blue to produce finished leather; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected by the officials of Central Pollution Control Board Regional Directorate Lucknow on dated May 10, 2018, and the following observations are made:

1. The unit was found operational and is engaged in processing of Wet Blue to produce Finished Leather, having Consented capacity of 4000 kg/day.
2. Unit has installed ZLD system as well as PTZ camera and has its connectivity.
3. Unit has Consent to Operate (valid up to 31.12.2018) under Water Act and Air Act.
4. Hazardous Waste Authorization of the unit is valid up to 04.06.2022.
5. Unit has installed ETP comprising of Physio-chemical & Biological treatment followed by three stages Reverse Osmosis for treatment and reuse of effluent.
6. Unit has installed single stage evaporator of 40 KLD which was operational for handling of RO reject.
7. Electromagnetic flow meter is installed at bore-well and at various locations of ETP such as ETP Inlet of collection tank RO feed line, single stage evaporator feed. Unit is also maintaining the logbook for these flow-meters.
8. Unit is member of TSDF Kanpur being operated by Bharat Oil & RAMKY. The ETP sludge is sent to TSDF for disposal.
9. Unit has 05 DG sets of capacity 2 nos of 380 KVA and 3 nos. of 180 KVA with acoustic enclosure and standard exhaust pipe. During visit, DG sets were operational with open doors of acoustic enclosure.
10. Total five (5 nos) drums of capacity 2*1000kg, 2*500kg and 1*200 kg were found installed within the premises of the unit for various processes.
11. Sample analysis results show pH 7.80 (against norm 6.5-9.0), **SS 482 mg/l** (against norm 100 mg/l), TDS 17958 mg/l, **Boron 6.58 mg/l** (against norm 2 mg/l), BOD 1193 mg/l, COD 3709 mg/l and Total Chromium 1.18 mg/l (against norm 2 mg/l) which indicate doubtful operation of ETP or un-stabilized ETP or inadequacy of ETP.

AND WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, the unit is required to carry out following suggestive measures besides other pollution control measures.

1. The unit shall prepare water balance cum water audit report including adequacy of ZLD system and submit the same to CPCB.
2. The unit shall ensure the operation of plant the operation of plant as per consented ZLD condition.
3. The unit shall ensure disposal of sludge/hazardous substance through TSDF unit.

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, **notice is hereby served to the Unit M/s Jama Corporation Pvt. Ltd., Vill- Khalipur, Teh- Akbarpur, Kanpur Dehat (U.P)-209311 to Show Cause, why the Unit should not be Closed** until necessary steps are taken to comply with the above mentioned suggestive measures within 45 days.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions, the CPCB may initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
