Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 - notice thereof.

WHEREAS, the Polythene & Plastic processed industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting Industries which have been discharging effluents directly or indirectly on land and into water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on land and the ambient water quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed thereunder; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install and operate Effluent Treatment plant (ETP) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the Rules framed thereunder and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCB)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the matter of Paryavaran Suraksha Samiti Vs Union of India & Others dated 22/02/2017 directed that no industry which requires "consent to operate" from the concerned Pollution Control Board, is permitted to function, unless it has a functional effluent treatment plant, which is capable to meet the prescribed norms for removing the pollutants from the effluent, before it is discharged; and

WHEREAS, a team of officers from the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), Delhi inspected M/s. Anand Buttons Limited, Sonapat, Haryana (herein after referred as the Unit) on June 26, 2018 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures and observed the following:

1. The analysis results of samples collected from ETP outlet exceeding the norms notified under E(P) rules, 1986 w.r.t TDS (2832 mg/l > 2100 mg/l).
2. The Unit has not installed flow meter at the bore wells & maintain logbook.
3. The Unit has not provided separate energy meter for ETP operation & maintain logbook as per the consent condition.

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the

Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof

NOW, THEREFORE, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, notice is hereby issued to **M/s Anand Buttons Limited, Sonapat, Haryana** to show cause as to why your unit be not directed to close down all operational activities with immediate effect until following directions are complied:


1. The unit shall upgrade/ maintain adequate Effluent Treatment Plant and operate it properly so as to achieve prescribed standards for effluent discharge.
2. The Unit shall install flow meter at the bore wells & maintain logbook.
3. The Unit shall provide separate energy meter for ETP operation & maintain logbook as per the consent condition.

The time bound action plan for compliance of above directions shall be submitted to Central Pollution Control Board within 30 days of the receipt of the directions. In case of failure to comply with the said directions necessary action as deemed fit under the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 will be taken by Central Pollution Control Board.
