**Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986-reg.**

**WHEREAS**, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, M/s Rajkumar Textile Mills, (hereafter referred as the Unit), is a textile industry located at A-16, Udyogpuram, Partapur, Meerut, Uttar Pradesh; and

**WHEREAS**, the unit was issued revoke directions dated 15<sup>th</sup> May, 2018 as follows:

- 1) The unit shall resume operation for a period of 45 days only from the date of receipt of directions.
- 2) The unit shall inform to CPCB regarding the date of resumption of operation.
- 3) The unit shall submit performance audit report of ETP system by reputed organization like IIT during this period.

**AND WHEREAS**, the unit, vide its letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> September, 2018, has submitted performance audit report carried out by CPPRI;

**WHEREAS**, CPCB Constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27/09/2017 having representative from CPCB, NMCG & MoEF & CC for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

**WHEREAS**, the Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> September, 2018 examined the performance audit report and recommended that:

- 1) Performance audit report from CPPRI states that the ETP system installed by the unit is working satisfactorily. The unit is therefore, recommended for revocation.
- 2) The unit shall submit monthly logbook data along with effluent analysis report from EPA recognized laboratory upto one year.

**AND NOW, THEREFORE**, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit, **M/s Rajkumar Textile Mills, A-16, Udyogpuram, Partapur, Meerut, Uttar Pradesh** is directed to comply with the following directions:

- 1) The unit may resume operations and inform to CPCB about date of resumption of operation immediately.
- 2) The unit shall submit monthly logbook data record along with effluent analysis report from EPA recognized lab up to one year.
- 3) The unit shall ensure proper operation of the ETP so as to achieve the stipulated standards and continuous transmission of data to CPCB server.

In case of failure of the unit to comply with the directions, action will be taken in accordance with the provisions under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

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
