Sub: Show Cause direction under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

WHEREAS, the cement plants are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed thereunder; and

WHEREAS, there is need to inculcate habit of self-monitoring within the industries for complying with the prescribed standards and this can be achieved by the methods like installing online emission monitoring devices; and

WHEREAS, for strengthening the monitoring and compliance through self-regulatory mechanism, online source emission and effluent monitoring systems need to be installed and operated by the industries on 'polluter pays principle'; and

WHEREAS, a direction under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 was issued on February 05, 2014, to all the State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs) for installation of online emission monitoring system w.r.t. PM, NOx and SO₂ in cement industries ; and

WHEREAS, considering the requests/representations received from industries/ industrial associations/ SPCBs /PCCs, an extension of time upto June 30, 2015 for installation of online monitoring systems was granted vide direction dated March 02, 2015 under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981; and

WHEREAS, a letter dated May 29, 2015 was issued by the Chairman, CPCB to all the SPCBs/ PCCs informing that no further extension of time will be given after June 30, 2015 and consent to operate will be withdrawn along with forfeiture of bank guarantee of non-complying units; and

WHEREAS, concerned SPCB/PCC issued directions under section 33A of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and section 31A of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, to install the online monitoring system by June 30, 2015 and to submit bank guarantee of 100% of the cost of online emission & effluent monitoring system; and

WHEREAS, Notice under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act 1986, was issued on July 24, 2015 to all cement plants, including M/s Ultratech Cement Ltd., Dalla Cement Works, Dalla, Distt. Sonbhadra, Uttar Pradesh to show-cause as to why the unit should not be closed down, if the unit has not complied fully with the directions issued w.r.t. installation of online emission monitoring system.

WHEREAS, a circular dated 23.12.2016 was uploaded on CPCB website stating that the all integrated cement plants of 200 TPD and above shall install OCEMS in all notified process stacks; and

WHEREAS, direction was issued to the unit vide letter dated 30.03.2017 and 21.04.2017, to submit action plan to comply revised norms of cement industries; and

WHEREAS, CPCB did not entertain any request for relaxation in these directions, hence the unit has to comply new norms latest by Aug. 2018; and

WHEREAS, M/s Ultratech Cement Ltd., Dalla Cement Works, Dalla, Distt. Sonbhadra, Uttar Pradesh was inspected by RD-Lucknow on 03/08/2018 to investigate a complaint and made following observations/shortcomings and recommendations:

- 1. The unit needs to upgrade APCDs at Coal mill (K4, K5) as emissions from the said stacks were exceeding the revised emission norms of PM-30 mg/Nm³ and NO_x-800 mg/Nm³ (coal mill K4, PM - 68.8 mg/Nm³; coal mill K5, PM-90.6 mg/Nm³, NO_x-904.05 mg/Nm³)**
- 2. The unit has installed OCEMS with Kiln and CPP stack only and not with cement mill, coal mill and cooler stack.**
3. The unit should asphalt all the internal roads in raw material storage areas.
4. The unit should provide easy ladder at K5 cooler stack.
5. The unit should request SPCB to issue amended consent incorporating information about DG Set.
6. The unit should install hazardous waste display board at the factory entrance.

WHEREAS, as per IT division report dated 24.08.2018, OCEMS was observed connected with CPCB server for Kiln and CPP stack only and not for cement mill, coal mill and cooler stack; and


WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change (MoEF&CC), Government of India, vide Notification No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof;


Now, THEREFORE, in view of above shortcomings and exercising the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, M/s Ultratech Cement Ltd., Dalla Cement Works, Dalla, Distt- Sonebhadra, Uttar Pradesh is hereby directed to show cause as to why the unit should not be directed to close operation for the above non-compliance and why environmental compensation be not imposed for violations of emission norms.

The industry shall submit reply and action taken report within 15 days from the date of issue of this Notice. In case of failure, the Board will be constrained to initiate action as deemed necessary and appropriate under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
