Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986-reg.

WHEREAS, Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Kamal Dyeing House, (hereafter referred as the Unit), is a textile industry located at B-5, Udyogpuram, Meerut-250103; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued direction dated 17th May, 2018 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit for compliance of following:

- 1) The unit may resume manufacturing operations for 45 days only and shall immediately inform to CPCB regarding the date of resumption of operations.
- 2) The unit will carry out performance audit of ETP system from a reputed Government institution within 45 days of resumption of operations and provide the performance audit report to CPCB.
- 3) The unit shall operate ETP properly so as to ensure with the effluent discharge norms notified under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
- 4) The unit shall ensure continuous connectivity of OCEMS system installed at the outlet of ETP with CPCB server.
- 5) The unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report within 30 days of resumption of operations from a laboratory recognized under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

AND WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letters dated 26th May, 2018, 19th June, 2018 and 5th September, 2018 were examined and following observations are made:

- 1) The unit informed CPCB that it shall resume its operation for 45 days from 28th May, 2018 onwards.
- 2) The unit also submitted a treated effluent analysis report vide its letter dated 19th June, 2018.
- 3) The unit has submitted performance audit report carried out by CPPRI as per the directions of CPCB.

WHEREAS, CPCB Constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27/09/2017 having representative from CPCB, NMCG & MoEF & CC for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and


WHEREAS, the Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 12th September 2018 examined the performance audit report and recommended that:

- 1) Performance audit report from CPPRI states that the ETP system installed by the unit is working satisfactorily. The unit is therefore, recommended for revocation.
- 2) The unit shall submit monthly logbook data along with effluent analysis report from environmental laboratory recognized under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 upto one year.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit, **M/s Kamal Dyeing House, B-5, Udyogpuram, Meerut-250103** is directed to comply with the following directions:

- 1) The unit shall resume operation and shall inform to CPCB about date of resumption of operation immediately.
- 2) The unit shall submit monthly logbook data record along with effluent analysis report from environmental laboratory recognized under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 up to one year on monthly basis.

In case of failure of the unit to comply with the directions, action will be taken in accordance with the provisions under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
