**Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 -reg.**

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed thereunder; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install and operate Effluent Treatment plant (ETP) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the Rules framed thereunder and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCB)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the matter of Paryavaran Suraksha Samiti Vs Union of India & Others dated 22/02/2017 directed that no industry which requires "consent to operate" from the concerned Pollution Control Board, is permitted to function, unless it has a functional effluent treatment plant, which is capable to meet the prescribed norms for removing the pollutants from the effluent, before it is discharged; and

WHEREAS, a team of officers from the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), Delhi inspected M/s JPG Electrical Pvt. Limited, Kila No. 4/7, 17, Village Kheri, Manjat, Sonapat (herein after referred as the Unit) on May 23, 2018 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures; and

WHEREAS, the inspecting team found that the Unit operational and observed the following:

1. The process of floor washing of the paint and powder coating area of the unit generates effluent.
2. As per effluent analysis results, treated effluent was not meeting general discharge effluent standards applicable for discharge on land for irrigation for pH (1.99 < 5.5), TSS (249 > 200 mg/l) and BOD (124 > 100 mg/l);
3. The Unit's ETP was observed without any Flow meter.
4. The Unit failed to produce any evidence of ETP sludge disposal.

WHEREAS, in view of the above and in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the following directions were issued vide letter no. B-29016/04/06/IPC-1/567 dated July 06, 2018:

1. The Unit shall close all the plant operations with immediate effect.

2. The Unit (M/s JPG Electrical Pvt. Limited, Kila No. 4/7, 17, Village Kheri, Manjat, Sonapat) shall operate Effluent Treatment Plant (ETP) properly so that the treated effluent conforms to the prescribed norms.
3. The unit shall install flow meter at ETP and shall maintain records of effluent generation and treatment.
4. The Unit shall dispose hazardous wastes in scientific manner with proper record maintenance.

WHEREAS, the Unit informed vide letter received on August 31, 2018 that they have complied with all the CPCB directions dated July 06, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Unit vide letter dated August 31, 2018 submitted Undertaking in stamp paper dully notarized; CTO from HSPCB valid up to 31.03.2019, Installed Flow meter at ETP and maintain the record of effluent generation & treatment and submitted copy of GEPIL (TSDF) agreement for ETP sludge scientific disposal with manifest form 10 from GEPIL; and

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 03.10.2017 having representative(s) from CPCB and MoEF&CC for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the three-member committee in its meeting held on 27.09.2018 examined the compliance report submitted by the Unit (M/s JPG Electrical Pvt. Limited, Sonapat) and recommended that the Unit may be allowed to resume its operations with conditions that:

1. The Unit shall submit performance audit report of ETP from expert Government Institution to CPCB within 60 days of start of operation.
2. The Unit shall submit monthly log book data of ETP for one month to CPCB.
3. The Unit shall get compliance verification from Haryana State Pollution Control Board and submit the report to CPCB within three months.

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.


**NOW, THEREFORE**, in exercise of powers vested to Chairman CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and in view of compliance with relevant direction under reference, the direction issued under the Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the Unit vide letter dated July 06, 2018 is hereby revoked with condition that:

1. The Unit shall submit performance audit report of ETP from expert Government Institution to CPCB within 60 days of start of operation.

2. The Unit shall submit monthly log book data of ETP for one month to CPCB.
3. The Unit shall comply with the effluent & emission norms prescribed in the consent to operate issued by Haryana State Pollution Control Board under the Water Act, 1974 and the Air Act, 1981.
4. The Unit shall get compliance verification from Haryana State Pollution Control Board and submit the report to CPCB within three months.

In case of non-compliance by the Unit action as deemed fit under the provisions of Environment (P) Act, 1986 shall be taken.
