**Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 – Notice thereof.**

WHEREAS, Fertilizer units are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality;

WHEREAS, there is need to inculcate habit of self-monitoring within the industries for complying with the prescribed standards and this can be achieved by the methods like installing online effluent and emission monitoring devices;

WHEREAS, a direction under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 was issued on February 05, 2014 to all the State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs) for installation of online emission monitoring system w.r.t. Urea Plants – PM, CAN/NPK/Ammonium Nitrite – PM, Ammonia, Fluoride, DAP plants – PM, Fluoride & SSP plants – PM, Fluoride parameters & online effluent monitoring system w.r.t. pH, Ammonical Nitrogen, Fluoride & Flow parameters in Fertilizer industries;

WHEREAS, Central Pollution Control Board issued notice under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to **M/s Coromandel International Ltd., Nimrani, Dist.- Khargone, Madhya Pradesh** on July 24, 2015 regarding installation of on line effluent and emission monitoring system.

WHEREAS, on the basis of SMS alerts generated by online monitoring system during a period of April to May, 2017 a team of officers from the Regional Directorate, Central Pollution Control Board, Bhopal visited the unit on June 22, 2017 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures; and

WHEREAS, the unit is zero liquid discharge unit and unit has not provided online connectivity of flow meter and web camera for continuous effluent monitoring as reported by IT division, CPCB on August 01, 2017; and

WHEREAS, it was observed that the source emission of SSP plant stack of the unit is not complying w.r.t emission standard of NO<sub>x</sub> (68 mg/Nm<sup>3</sup> > 50 mg/Nm<sup>3</sup>) as prescribed by Madhya Pradesh Pollution Control Board; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under;

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** based on all facts and observations, in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 M/s **Coromandel International Ltd., Nimrani, Dist.- Khargone, Madhya Pradesh** is hereby directed to close all manufacturing/production activities until it complies with the following directions:

1. The unit shall upgrade air pollution control system of SSP stack so that the discharged emissions conform to the prescribed standards.
2. The unit shall provide online connectivity of flow meter and web camera to Central Pollution Control Board.

In case of failure to comply with the said directions necessary action as deemed fit under the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986 will be taken.
