**Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 -reg.**

WHEREAS, the Textiles (Dyeing) industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting Industries which have been discharging effluents directly or indirectly on land and into water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on land and the ambient water quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed thereunder; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install and operate Effluent Treatment plant (ETP) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the Rules framed thereunder and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCB)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the matter of Paryavaran Suraksha Samiti Vs Union of India & Others dated 22/02/2017 directed that no industry which requires "consent to operate" from the concerned Pollution Control Board, is permitted to function, unless it has a functional effluent treatment plant, which is capable to meet the prescribed norms for removing the pollutants from the effluent, before it is discharged; and

WHEREAS, a team of official of Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), Regional Directorate, Lucknow inspected M/s. Weave N Colors Texofab, Plot No. 490, HSIIDC Barhi, Sonipat, Haryana (herein after referred as the Unit) on April 03, 2019 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures and the inspecting team observed the following:

1. The Unit was operational but ETP of the Unit was found non-operational during visit and ETP of the Unit was found almost in defunct condition.
2. The waste water generated from the process may be considered as outlet of ETP and characteristics of the effluent was not meeting the CETP inlet norms w.r.t. pH: 5.92 < 6.0-9.0, COD: 4204 > 1400 mg/l, BOD: 1702 > 500 mg/l, TDS: 5020 > 2100 mg/l, Sulphide: 08 > 02 mg/l.
3. The Total Chromium contain in the effluent is very high i.e 10.98 > 2.0 mg/l.
4. The Unit has not obtained Hazardous Waste Authorization from HSPCB under Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
5. The Unit has not provided designated area for temporary storage of Hazardous Waste and Unit is not maintaining the proper records of Hazardous Waste generation & disposal.
6. The Unit is not maintaining records of ground water withdrawal.

WHEREAS, a closure direction under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act 1986 was issued to the Unit vide letter no. B-29016/04/06/IPC-1/2107 dated May 27,

2019 on the basis of non-compliance observed during inspection by the inspecting team; and

WHEREAS, the Unit has informed vide letter dated June 03, 2019 submitted copy of adequacy report of ETP from Deenbandhu Chhotu Ram University of Science & Technology, Sonapat, report of ETP sludge from GEPIL, photograph of storage facility for Hazardous waste and record of Hazardous Waste generation & disposal, valid HW authorisation from HSPCB up to 30.09.2022 and provided CGWA records of ground water withdrawal & requested to revoke the closure direction; and

WHEREAS, the Unit vide letter dated June 04, 2019 submitted self-certificate stated that the Unit has stopped production w.e.f. May 27, 2019 and also informed the same to Regional Office Sonipat; and

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 03.10.2017 having representative(s) from CPCB and MoEF&CC for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the three-member committee in its meeting held on 19.07.2019 examined the compliance report submitted by the Unit and recommended the following conditions:

1. The unit shall submit performance assessment of the treatment system by analysis of treated effluent by same Government Institution who had conducted adequacy report within 60 days of start of operation.
2. The Unit shall store hazardous waste at designated storage facility and properly maintain log book of disposal of Hazardous Waste (s) to the TSDF and submit the copy of manifest within 15 days.
3. The Unit shall properly maintain log book of ground water withdrawal.
4. The Unit shall implement recommendations of adequacy report in time bound manner.

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.


NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested to Chairman CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and in view of compliance with relevant direction under reference, the direction issued under the Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the Unit M/s. Weave N Colors Texofab, Plot No. 490, HSIIDC Barhi, Sonipat, Haryana vide letter dated May 27, 2019 is hereby revoked with the following conditions:

1. The unit shall submit performance assessment of the treatment system by analysis of treated effluent by same Government Institution who had conducted adequacy report within 60 days of start of operation. The report shall also indicate periodicity of replacing filter media.

2. The Unit shall store hazardous waste at designated storage facility and properly maintain log book of disposal of Hazardous Waste (s) to the TSDF and submit the copy of manifest within 15 days.
3. The Unit shall properly maintain log book of ground water withdrawal.
4. The Unit shall implement recommendations of adequacy report in time bound manner.

The Unit (M/s. Weave N Colors Texofab, Plot No. 490, HSIIDC Barhi, Sonipat, Haryana) shall ensure compliance to the norms. In case of non-compliance by the Unit action as deemed fit under the provisions of Environment (P) Act, 1986 shall be taken.
