SHOW CAUSE NOTICE UNDER SECTION-5 OF ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Govt. of India, vide notification S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated powers vested under Section-5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue direction to any industry or any local body or any other Authority for violations of emission and effluent standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install Effluent Treatment Plants (ETPs) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under and also to meet the consent conditions granted by the State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs)/Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, M/s Tirubala Exports Plot No A-3/3 & A-3/2 Jainpur Industrial Area, Kanpur Dehat (U.P) (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') was inspected under National Ganga River Basin Authority (NGRBA) Programme on 31/05/2017 by team of CPCB Regional Directorate (North), Lucknow and the following observations were made:

1. During inspection, the industry was found operational with generation of 58m³ of wastewater.
2. During inspection, it was observed that the unit was processing 400 hides/day as raw material to produce finished leather.
3. The industry has valid consents for Water Act, 1974 and Air Act, 1981, till 31/12/2019.
4. The industry has valid authorization of handling of Hazardous & other Waste till 6/6/2017 and has applied for its renewal to UPPCB.

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5. The unit has not obtained NOC from CGWA.
6. During inspection, the CRP was not in operation.
7. The unit has consent for processing wet blue to finished leather, but without prior permission from UPPCB the unit was found processing raw hides to finished leather.
8. The unit has installed online continuous effluent monitoring system for measuring the consent parameters in compliance with CPCB/SPCB direction.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and exercising powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section-5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, notice is hereby served to the Unit to **Show Cause why the Unit should not be closed down for (i) processing raw hides in place of wet blue to produce finished leather without prior permission (consent to operate) from UPPCB, (ii) not having valid Hazardous Waste Authorization (HWA) and (iii) why CRP was not in operational state during the inspection.**

The reply to the Show Cause Notice shall be submitted within 15 days from the receipt of this notice, failing which suitable action as deemed fit under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 will be initiated.
