Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, the tannery and leather industries are also identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly in to ambient Air and Water, having potential to threat to cause adverse effects on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, M/s Navratan Industries, 532-533, 150 Feet Rd., Jajmau, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is a Tannery industry and was inspected by CPCB officials on 25th May, 2017 to verify the compliance status; and

WHEREAS, the inspection team made the following observations:

- 1) The unit was found operational at the time of the inspection.
- 2) The unit utilizes about 71 m³/day of water with a waste water generation of 58 m³/day.
- 3) The unit has air and water consent valid upto 31st December, 2017. However, the hazardous waste authorization of the unit expired on 11th June, 2017.
- 4) No specific measures for water conservation and waste minimization measure have been taken by the unit as per the inspection team.
- 5) The unit has installed OCEMS which is connected to CPCB server.
- 6) The analysis results of the samples taken from the outlet of PETP showed **pH-3.52 (against prescribed norms of 6-5-9.0)**, TSS - 345 mg/l (against prescribed norms of 600 mg/l) and Chromium - 2.0 mg/l (against prescribed norms of 2.0 mg/l) which indicate non-compliance w.r.t pH.

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It is evident from the above observations that the unit, M/s Navratan Industries, 532-533, 150 Feet Rd., Jajmau, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh is discharging partially treated effluent posing potential threat to the surrounding environment;

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit M/s Navratan Industries, 532-533, 150 Feet Rd., Jajmau, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh is hereby directed to close down its operation and shall not resume until the necessary pollution control measures are planned and implemented so as to comply with the prescribed effluent discharge norms to the satisfaction of CPCB.
