DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS the Central Government has notified the Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016 and amendments thereof (herein after referred as BMWWM Rules) in suppression of the Bio-Medical Waste (Management & Handling) Rules, 1998, and amendments thereof, under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to improve the collection, segregation, processing, treatment and disposal of the Bio-Medical wastes in an environmentally sound management thereby, reducing the biomedical waste generation and its impact on the environment;

WHEREAS Rule 4 of BMWWM Rules, 2016 stipulated duties of the occupier of Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility (CBWTF);

WHEREAS as per Rule 7 (1) of BMWWM Rules, "bio-medical waste shall be treated and disposed of in accordance with Schedule I and in compliance with the standards prescribed in Schedule II of the BMWWM Rules, 2016";

WHEREAS Rules 14(1) of BMWWM Rules, "every authorized person shall maintain records related to generation, collection, segregation, storage, transportation, treatment, disposal and or any form of handling of Bio-Medical waste in accordance with these Rules and by guidelines issued";

WHEREAS the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, in the matter of O.A. No. 710 of 2017 filed by Shailesh Singh vide order dated 12.03.2019 directed "CPCB to undertake study and prepare a scale of compensation to be recovered from violators of Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016. Hon'ble NGT also states that scale of compensation must be different, rendering violation of Rules to be non-profitable and which should be adequate to remedy the situation".

WHEREAS in pursuant to Order dated 12.03.2019 passed by Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, in the matter of O.A. No. 710 of 2017, CPCB has prepared Guidelines for "Imposition of Environmental Compensation Charges (ECC) against Healthcare Facilities (HCFs) and Common Biomedical Waste Treatment Facilities (CBWTFs)";

WHEREAS the Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility (CBWTF) namely M/s Golden Eagle Waste Management Company, V.P.O. Jasana, Tigaon Road, Faridabad – 121002, Haryana (the Unit) was inspected by Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) on 05.06.2019 and following short comings were made:

- a) Separate spacing for treatment equipment is not provided as required under BMWWM Rules, 2016;
- b) Value of Particulate Matter (PM) found exceeding (i.e. 2200 mg/Nm³) against standard of 50 mg/Nm³ prescribed under BMWWM Rules, 2016;
- c) Values of BOD (i.e. 194 mg/l) and COD (i.e. 374 mg/l) found exceeding the prescribed standard of 30 mg/l and 250 mg/l respectively;
- d) Combustion efficiency (92.66%) also found less than prescribed limit of 99.00 % as per BMWWM Rules, 2016;
- e) Online Continuous Emission Monitoring System (OCEMS) found not having connectivity with CPCB server;
- f) Certificate for upgradation of incinerator for 2 sec Residence Time in Secondary Combustion Chamber was not available with Unit;

g) Unit has not provided separate room for storage of incineration ash as well as ETP sludge;

WHEREAS Unit vide letter dated 04.07.2019 has submitted its reply indicating action taken on the observations of CPCB made during inspection and also enclosed copy of monitoring results for incinerator stack.

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Unit is hereby directed to:

- a. submit the monitoring results for incinerator stack emission as well as for ETP wastewater treated effluent from laboratory approved under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 or NABL accredited laboratory;
- b. submit data sheet on technical specification of incinerator as per CPCB guidelines for Verification, of Two Second Residence Time in Secondary Combustion Chamber of Incinerator;
- c. Submit reply supported with relevant documents and photographs showing actions taken against above short comings showing action taken against above short comings within 30 days from the receipt of this directions.

In case Unit fails to comply with above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate proceeding against M/s Golden Eagle Waste Management Company, V.P.O. Jasana, Tigaon Road, Faridabad – 121002, Haryana as deemed fit under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
