**DIRECION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986**

**WHEREAS**, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act,1986 and the rules framed there under; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Govt. of India, vide notification S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act,1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue direction to any industry, Municipal Corporation, Municipal Council, Cantonment Board to any local or other Authority for the violation of emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules,1986; and

**WHEREAS**, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install effluent treatment plants (ETPs) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the Rules framed thereunder and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCBs) / Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

**WHEREAS**, the inspection of **M/s Tirupati Textile Mills, Plot No. A-187/1, MIDC Phase-I, Dombivali, Tal. Kalyan, Dist. Thane, Maharashtra (hereinafter referred as 'the Unit')** was carried out on 12.06.2019 by the team from CPCB, Regional Directorate, Vadodara in compliance of Hon'ble NGT order dated 07.12.2016, in matter of O.A No. 37/2013 (Vanshakti&Ors. Vs MPCB &Ors.).The unit is textile processing unit. Following major observations were made by the team during the visit:

1. During inspection the unit was found in operation.
2. The Unit is having valid combined Consent & Authorization under the Air Act, 1981 and Water Act, 1974 & Hazardous Waste Rules 2016 with validity upto 31.10.2021.
3. The Unit has provided an ETP of capacity 800KLD, comprising of Collection cum Equalization tank > Settling tank > Storage tank > Pressure sand filter > Activated carbon filter > discharge to MIDC drainage system for further treatment at CETP.
4. During the visit, the team has collected grab sample of wastewater from ETP. Analysis results reveals that the concentrations of all measured parameters such as; pH: 6.33 against 6-9; TSS: 111mg/l against 500 mg/l; NH3-N: 6.17 mg/l against 50mg/l; COD:



845 mg/l against 1600mg/l; BOD: 312 mg/l against 800mg/l& O&G 6.9mg/l against 10mg/l of the final outlet of ETP are within MPCB discharge standards as per CCA.

5. During visit, it was raining and the surface runoff from the industry premises joining to domestic drain at the back side of the unit was found alkaline in pH strip. Grab sample of the runoff wastewater was collected for analysis and the results are as below:

The analysis result shows significant contamination of the surface runoff.

**Whereas**, it is evident from the above observations that due to poor housekeeping, on ground storage of various dyes and chemicals, spillages and leakages near NaOH storage might have resulted the said contamination of surface runoff.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in view of the above, and exercising the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, **notice is served herewith to show cause why M/s Tirupati Textile Mills, Plot No. A-187/1, MIDC Phase-I, Dombivali, Tal. Kalyan, Dist. Thane, Maharashtra** should not be closed down until time bound action plan for all necessary pollution control measures and best environmental practices is implemented.

You are hereby given an opportunity to file your objections (if any) to the above proposed notice within 20 days from the receipt of this notice, failing which it will be presumed that you have nothing to say and appropriate action, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, will be taken against the Unit without giving any further notice.
