**Sub.: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986-regarding**

WHEREAS, the Pharmaceutical industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed thereunder; and

WHEREAS, there is need to inculcate habit of self-monitoring within the industries for complying with the prescribed standards and this can be achieved by the methods like installing online effluent and emission monitoring devices; and

WHEREAS, Gujarat organics ltd., Plot No-127/1, GIDC Estate, Ankleshwar Distt. Bharuch, Gujarat (herein after referred as the Unit) which comes under Pharmaceutical category, has installed Online continuous effluent Monitoring system (OCEMS) and provide connectivity to CPCB server; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was randomly selected for inspection under OCEMS Surveillance programme during April - May 2019; and

WHEREAS, a team of officers from the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), Regional Directorate, Vadodara inspected the Unit on July 11, 2019 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures; and

WHEREAS, the inspecting team found the Unit operational and observed the following:


1. The analysis results treated effluent from ETP outlet indicate that the parameter TSS (342 mg/l > 150 mg/l), TDS (20285mg/l >10000mg/l), BOD (270 mg/l > 200mg/l), exceeds the prescribed standards.
2. Hazardous waste stored more than 90 days (April 2018 to March 2019) without leachate collection system.

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.



You are hereby given an opportunity to file your objections (if any) to the above directions within 15 days from the receipt of this notice, failing which action as deemed fit under the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 will be taken against the Unit.
