**DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT,  
1986**

**WHEREAS**, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Govt. of India, vide notification S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue direction to any industry, Municipal Corporation, Municipal Council, Cantonment Board to any local or other Authority for the violation of emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986; and

**WHEREAS**, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install effluent treatment plants (ETPs) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the Rules framed thereunder and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCBs) / Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

**WHEREAS**, the unit was inspected by the officials of CPCB on 27.06.2012 for the verification of compliance by the unit, and was found closed and it was informed that the plant was not in operation since 2009; and

**WHEREAS**, CPCB issued direction under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 dated 18/01/2016 to M/s Jagatjit Industries regarding failure in installation of online monitoring system.

**WHEREAS**, the unit was self closed since 2009; and

**WHEREAS**, units reply vide letter dated 23.08.2019 was examined and following observations are made;

1. The unit M/s Jagatjeet Industries Ltd., is now named as ADS distilleries Pvt, Ltd.,

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2. The unit has submitted the proposal to revive the unit by starting the bottling plant in first phase.
3. The unit will procure ENA from the market for bottling operation.
4. The unit has Effluent Treatment Plant (ETP) of 70 KLD capacity.
5. The ETP consists of Equalization tank, ph adjuster, Primary Clarifier, Aeration tank, Secondary clarifier, Sludge drying bed, and sludge collection pits.
6. The unit has installed online monitoring system for pH, COD, BOD, TSS & flow meter and provided the connectivity to CPCB.
7. The unit has submitted application dated 16.05.2019 to UPPCB for consent to operate for bottling plant only.

**AND WHEREAS**, the unit has submitted adequacy assessment report of ETP prepared by HBTI, Kanpur, which indicates that the ETP is adequate to treat 70 KLD effluent; and

**WHEREAS**, CPCB constituted a Three –member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF & CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB. The Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 17.09.2019 examined the reply of the unit and recommended for revocation; and

**NOW THEREFORE**, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Unit, M/s ADS Distilleries, U.P, is directed to comply with the following:

1. The unit shall operate only bottling plant for 60 days after obtaining valid consent to operate from UPPCB and shall not operate any fermentation and distillation process/distillery operation.
2. The unit shall immediately inform to CPCB about resumption of operations to ensure performance assessment of ETP within 60 days.
3. The unit shall seek permission for operation from CPCB after 60 days.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions by the Unit, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate action against the Unit, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.


