Sub: Direction under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

WHEREAS, the cement industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change has notified emission norms for Particulate matter, SO₂ & NO_x vide GSR 612 (E) dated 25.08.2014; and amended it vide GSR 496 (E) dated 09.05.2016 for all cement industries and vide GSR 497 (E) dated 10.05.2016 for cement industries carrying out co-processing of wastes in their cement kilns; and

WHEREAS, in view of the above, the deadline was extended upto March 31, 2017 to comply with the aforesaid notified emission standards; and

WHEREAS, the matter regarding reconsideration of notified standards was taken up by the Cement industries with the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC) and it was decided by MoEF&CC that general extension shall not be granted and any extension regarding compliance shall be based on due assessment and submission of clear/specific road map for compliance with notified standards in a time bound manner. Accordingly, Directions under Section 3 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 have been issued by MoEF&CC to CPCB on 28.03.2017 to ensure implementation of notified environmental standards for cement industries; and

WHEREAS, no extension of time beyond August 30, 2018 is granted to cement units to comply the revised notified norms; and

WHEREAS, CPCB and Rajasthan SPCB carried out a joint inspection of M/s Mangalam Cement Limited, (Unit I, II and III), Morak, Distt Kota, Rajasthan, during October 16-18, 2019 w.r.t "no data availability" on CPCB central portal and assessment of its compliance status and following observation were made:

1. During source emission monitoring, PM emissions from kiln-1, kiln-2 Cement mill-2, Cement mill-3 And CPP were found within norms however, PM emission from cooler-2 (i.e. 42 mg/Nm³) was found exceeding with the PM emission norm (i.e. 30 mg/Nm³).

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2. Fugitive emission was measured and found within the guideline limit, however, visible emissions were observed at transfer points of conveyor belts, raw material gantry, clinker stockpiles, CPP coal yard, and cement packing section area and therefore, house keeping requires improvement.
3. Truck movements in front of industry gate were causing resuspension of road dust.

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof;

Now, THEREFORE, in view of the above and exercising the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, M/s Mangalam Cement Limited, (Unit I, II and III), Morak, Distt. Kota, Rajasthan, is hereby directed to take remedial measures to comply the emission norms in cooler-II Stack and improve maintenance/housekeeping and submit action taken report along with stack emission report from an Environment (Protection) Act recognized laboratory and pointwise details of the action taken within one month from the date of issue of this direction. In case of failure, the Board will be constrained to initiate action as deemed necessary and appropriate under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
