DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries have been identified as one the Grossly Polluting Industries (GPI) which have been discharging effluents directly or indirectly on land and into water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on land and the ambient water quality; and

WHEREAS, there is need to inculcate habit of self-monitoring within the industries for complying with the prescribed standards and this can be achieved by methods like installing online effluent and emission monitoring devices; and

WHEREAS, for strengthening the monitoring and compliance through self-regulatory mechanism, online source emission and effluent monitoring systems need to be installed and operated by the industries on 'polluter pays principle'; and

WHEREAS, M/s Keshav Industries Ltd. Khasara No.-290, Delhi-Garh Road, Near Petrol Pump, Dhaulana, Pilakhuwa, Uttar Pradesh (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') involved in Padding, Dyeing and Printing of fabric and cotton cloth; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued direction dated 15.05.2017 under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit for installation of online effluent monitoring system; and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected by a team of officials from IIT Delhi authorized by CPCB to verify the compliance status and following observations were made:

1. The unit was operational on the day of visit.
2. Consent to operate has been applied for the year 2017, but copy of application as well as date of filling of application and other details were not provided.
3. Online Continuous Effluent Monitoring System (OCEMS) has not been installed in the unit.
4. Water meter was not installed at Borewell and flow meter was also not installed at discharge outlet point.
5. The unit does not have permission from CGWA for extraction of groundwater.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction dated 21.06.2017 under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit for non-installation of online continuous effluent monitoring system (OCEMS); and

WHEREAS, the unit's reply vide letter dated 10.10.2019 was examined and following observations were made:

1. The unit has stopped its manufacturing operations w.e.f. 01.07.2017. The unit has submitted self-certificate dated 10.10.2019.
2. The unit has installed flowmeter at ETP outlet.

3. The unit has provided details regarding OCEMS installation and its connectivity with CPCB server
4. The unit has provided copies of application seeking consent under Air & Water Acts for effluent discharge of 6 KLD.
5. The unit has provided copy of NOC submitted to CGWA for groundwater abstraction.

AND WHEREAS, IT division, CPCB verified the connectivity of OCEMS (Web camera and flow meter); and

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27th September, 2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF & CC & NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three Member Committee in its meeting held on December 09, 2019 examined the documents and recommended the revocation of directions dated 21.06.2017 issued under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit **M/s Keshav Industries Ltd. Khasara No.-290, Delhi-Garh Road, Near Petrol Pump, Dhaulana, Pilakhuwa, Uttar Pradesh** is directed to comply with the following directions:

1. The unit may resume its manufacturing operations after obtaining consent to operate under Water and Air act and authorization under Hazardous Waste Management rules from UPPCB.
2. The unit shall obtain permission from CGWA for extraction of groundwater.
3. The unit shall ensure uninterrupted transmission of the OCEMS data to CPCB server.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
