Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986- reg.

WHEREAS, the Textile Processing Unit (fabric printing) have been identified as one of the Grossly Polluting Industries (GPI) which have been discharging effluent directly or indirectly on land and into water, having potential threat to cause adverse effects on land and the ambient water quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Govt. of India, vide notifications No. S.O. 157 E of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof;

AND WHEREAS, a team authorized by Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) inspected **M/s Uchit International Khasra No- 214, 215, 216 & 199 (K), Modhopur, Farrukhabad, UP** (herein after referred as the Unit) on 29.03.2017 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures and following observations were made:

1. Industrial unit was under operation and waste water generated was treated in effluent treatment plant. The treated effluent is having BOD of 3 mg/l, COD 76 mg/l, TDS 406 mg/l and was been used for irrigation purpose; and
2. Consent to operate of the units was valid upto 31.12.2017.
3. The unit have not installed online effluent monitoring system; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction dated 31.05.2017 under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit for non-installation of online continuous effluent monitoring system (OCEMS); and

WHEREAS, the unit's replies vide letters dated 16.01.2019, 26.02.2019, 15.03.2019 and 02.10.2019 and 03.12.2019 were examined and following observations are made:

1. The unit has stopped its manufacturing operations w.e.f. 01.07.2017. The unit has submitted self-certificate dated 10.10.2019.
2. The unit has installed flowmeter at ETP outlet.
3. The unit has provided details of OCEMS installation and its connectivity with CPCB server.
4. The unit has provided copies of consent seeking form under Air & Water Act.
5. The unit has provided copy of NOC submitted to CGWA for groundwater abstraction.

AND WHEREAS, it has been verified by IT division, CPCB that the unit has installed only flow meter and provided its connectivity to CPCB server; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued letters dated 28.01.2019, 22.02.2019 and email on 01.03.2019 to the unit of installation of complete OCEMS (flow meter and web camera) and provide its connectivity to CPCB server; and

WHEREAS, the unit's reply vide letters dated 24.11.2019 and 03.12.2019 were examined and following observations are made:

1. The unit has provided details of OCEMS installation and its connectivity with CPCB server.

AND WHEREAS, IT division, CPCB verified that the unit has provided OCEMS (Flow meter and web camera) and also provided data connectivity to CPCB server; and


WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27th September, 2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF & CC & NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three Member Committee in its meeting held on December 09, 2019 examined the documents and recommended for revocation of directions dated 21.06.2017 issued under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit **M/s Uchit International Khasra No- 214, 215, 216 & 199 (K), Modhopur, Farrukhabad, UP** is directed to comply with the following directions:

1. The unit may resume its manufacturing operations after obtaining valid consent to operate (8 KLD treated effluent discharge limit) under Water and Air Acts from UPPCB.
2. The unit shall ensure uninterrupted transmission of OCEMS data to CPCB server.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
