**DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986**

**WHEREAS**, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries have been identified as one the Grossly Polluting Industries (GPI) which have been discharging effluents directly or indirectly on land and into water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on land and the ambient water quality; and

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to inculcate habit of self monitoring within the industries for complying with the prescribed standards and this can be achieved by the methods like installing online effluent and emission monitoring devices; and

**WHEREAS**, for strengthening the monitoring and compliance through self regulatory mechanism, online source emission and effluent monitoring systems need to be installed and operated by the industries on 'polluter pays principle'; and

**WHEREAS**, a direction under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 was issued on February 05, 2014 to all 11 Ganga Basin State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs) / Pollution Control Committee (PCC) for installation of online effluent monitoring system w.r.t. pH, BOD, TSS, COD and flow parameters in Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries; and

**WHEREAS**, it was clarified that flow meter & web camera may be installed in case of units with Zero Liquid Discharge (ZLD) by March 31, 2015 vide guidelines uploaded on website of CPCB dated November 7, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, considering the requests/representations received from industries/industrial associations/SPCBs/PCCS, an extension of time up to June 30, 2015 for installation of online monitoring systems was granted vide direction dated March 27, 2015 under section 18 (1) (b) of Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974; and

**WHEREAS**, a letter vide dated May 29, 2015 was issued by CPCB to all the SPCBs/PCCs informing that no further extension of time will be given after June 30, 2015 and withdrawal of consents to operate along with forfeiture of bank guarantee of non-complying units will be the only option; and

**WHEREAS**, M/s Reliance Industries Ltd, Unit-I and II, UPSIDC Industrial Area, Naini, Allahabad, Uttar Pradesh (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') manufactures Polyester oriented yarn.

**WHEREAS**, a direction under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 regarding installation of online effluent monitoring system has been issued to unit on dated 30-07-2015 and hereby directed to comply with the following directions:

The Unit shall submit documentary evidence regarding status of installation of online effluent monitoring system. The unit shall submit the details through

- b. Uploading the data on the link provided on CPCB website (www.cpcb.nic.in) and
- c. By speed post

to the Member Secretary, Central Pollution Control Board.

**WHEREAS**, the Unit was inspected by a team of officials from Central Pollution Control Board on 26.05.2017 to verify the compliance of stipulated norms. During inspection unit was found non-operational. As per information Unit-I is closed since 01-10-2015 and Unit-II is closed since October, 2012.

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

**AND NOW, THEREFORE**, in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the following directions are being issued:

The Unit (**M/s Reliance Industries Limited, Unit-I and II, UPSIDC Industrial Area, Naini, Allahabad, Uttar Pradesh-211008**) shall remain close and not carry out any manufacturing operation till;

- 1) The unit install online Continuous effluent monitoring system and connected to CPCB server
- 2) The unit obtain a valid consent to operate from Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board
- 3) ETP be modified to meet the standards for discharge of all parameters notified for the unit
- 4) After completion of the above said measures, the Unit shall report to Central Pollution Control Board and seek permission before resumption of any manufacturing operation

Failure to comply with above directions will attract action in accordance with the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
