**Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.**

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, all industries are required to install and regularly operate the requisite, pollution control facilities to comply with the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants; and

WHEREAS, CPCB has developed a protocol for selection of industries for inspection based on SMS alerts generated from OCEMS due to non-compliance of effluent discharge norms and non-connectivity of OCEMS; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s. Tata International Ltd., Agra-Mumbai Road Industrial Area, Dewas, Madhya Pradesh, (hereafter referred as "Unit") was selected for inspection in view of offline status of OCEMS [Online Continuous Effluent Monitoring Systems] for a period of more than 30 days during Aug-Sep, 2019; and

WHEREAS, inspection of the Unit was conducted by a team of officers from the Regional Directorate, CPCB, Bhopal on December 05, 2019 to check the status of compliance of prescribed norms; and

WHEREAS, the unit has full-fledged infrastructure for processing of wet blue raw cow, goat, sheep & buffaloes skins to finished leather with installed capacity of 60 lac sq. ft./month. As observed by the CPCB team, the Unit is required to take the following corrective measures:

WHEREAS, the unit has full-fledged infrastructure for processing of wet blue raw cow, goat, sheep & buffaloes skins to finished leather with installed capacity of 60 lac sq. ft./month. As observed by the CPCB team, the Unit is required to take the following corrective measures:

- a) To ensure that installed OCEMS devices including flow meter and web camera are calibrated properly and data from devices are uninterruptedly transferred to CPCB Server.
- b) To complete installation/operationalization of Aerated Thin Film Dryer (ATFD)/MEE so as to treat the entire RO reject appropriately rather than storage in the sludge evaporation ponds.
- c) To analyse/monitor the quality parameters of the treated effluent regularly. The effluent samples should also be taken at the point from where the effluent is discharged for horticulture propose. The unit should strengthen the Environment Department and Monitoring Cell as unit comes under red category and various compliances are required as per current and upcoming Rules/Environmental Policies.
- d) To construct peripheral wall and collection pit inside the HW storage area.
- e) To improve the housekeeping especially in sludge handling area.
- f) To follow the "Guidelines for Utilisation of Treated Effluent in Irrigation", which are available on the website of CPCB at the web-link <https://cpcb.nic.in/NGT/Guidelines-UTE-Irrigation.pdf>

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section-5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Unit is hereby directed as follow:

1. The unit shall acknowledge the receipt of these directions within 7 days from the date of receipt of the directions.
2. The Unit shall immediately initiate corrective measures as described above in a time-targeted manner. All the actions be completed within 45 days from the date of receipt of the directions.


