DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, Tannery industries are identified as one of Grossly Polluting Industries (GPI) which have been discharging effluent directly or indirectly on land and into water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on land the ambient water quality; and

WHEREAS, there is need to inculcate habit of self-monitoring within the industries for complying with the prescribed standards and this can be achieved by the methods like installing online effluent and emission monitoring devices; and

WHEREAS, for strengthening the monitoring and compliance through self-regulatory mechanism, online source emission and effluent monitoring systems need to be installed and operated by the industries on 'polluter pays principle'; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of emission and effluent standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, it was clarified that flow meter & web camera may be installed in case of Units with Zero Liquid Discharge (ZLD) by March 31, 2015 vide guidelines uploaded on website of CPCB dated November 7, 2014; and

WHEREAS, as part of surveillance of industries in Ganga Basin to assess their status of compliance to pollution control norms, the inspection of Grossly Polluting Industries was got conducted by CPCB during April 2017; and

WHEREAS, inspection of **M/s Shoab Leathers, 332/308- A, Bhalla Estate, Jajmau, Kanpur-10, U.P.** (hereinafter referred as ' the unit') was conducted on April 6,2017 to check the status of compliance of prescribed norms and status of OCEMS (flow meter) web connectivity; and

WHEREAS, the unit found processing of raw hide to finished leather by Chrome tannery process at a processing capacity of 5 hides/day (125 kg/day); and

WHEREAS, effluent sample collected from PETP was found meeting the prescribed primary treatment standards; pH-8.58 (Standard: 6.5-9.0), TSS: 96 mg/l (Standard-600 mg/l) and Chrome: 2.0 mg/l (Standard-2 mg/l); and

WHEREAS, the unit has installed OCEMS (flow meter) and was found online connectivity however, the unit has not registered OCEMS details with CPCB at industrial registration portal; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued a show cause notice vide letter dated 22.06.2017; and

WHEREAS, unit replied vide its letter dated 05-07-2017, wherein it was informed that the unit has installed OCEMS and provided connectivity to CPCB server; and

WHEREAS, IT division, CPCB has confirmed that the unit has provided OCEMS data connectivity to CPCB server; and

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit **M/s Shoaib Leathers, 332/308- A, Bhalla Estate, Jajmau, Kanpur-10, U.P.** is directed to comply with the following direction:

1. The Unit shall operate ETP properly so as to ensure compliance with the effluent discharge norms notified under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. At any stage, if the treated effluent does not meet notified discharge standards the unit shall close down manufacturing operations immediately and report to CPCB.
2. The unit shall ensure continuous connectivity with CPCB server.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate action without any further notice, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
