**SHOW CAUSE NOTICE UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT  
(PROTECTION) ACT, 1986**

**WHEREAS**, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Govt. of India, vide notification S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue direction to any industry, Municipal Corporation, Municipal Council, Cantonment Board to any local or other Authority for the violation of emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986; and

**WHEREAS**, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install effluent treatment plants (ETPs) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the Rules framed there under and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCBs) / Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

**WHEREAS**, M/s Wave Distilleries & Breweries Ltd., (Distillery Division) U.P. (hereinafter referred as 'the Unit') is involved in manufacturing of extra neutral alcohol and rectified spirit using molasses as raw material and its brewery unit is involved in manufacturing of beer using broken rice as raw material; and

**WHEREAS**, CPCB carries out monitoring of recipient drains of grossly polluting industries (GPIs) & industrial cluster to assess impact of episodal effluent discharge on recipient water bodies; and

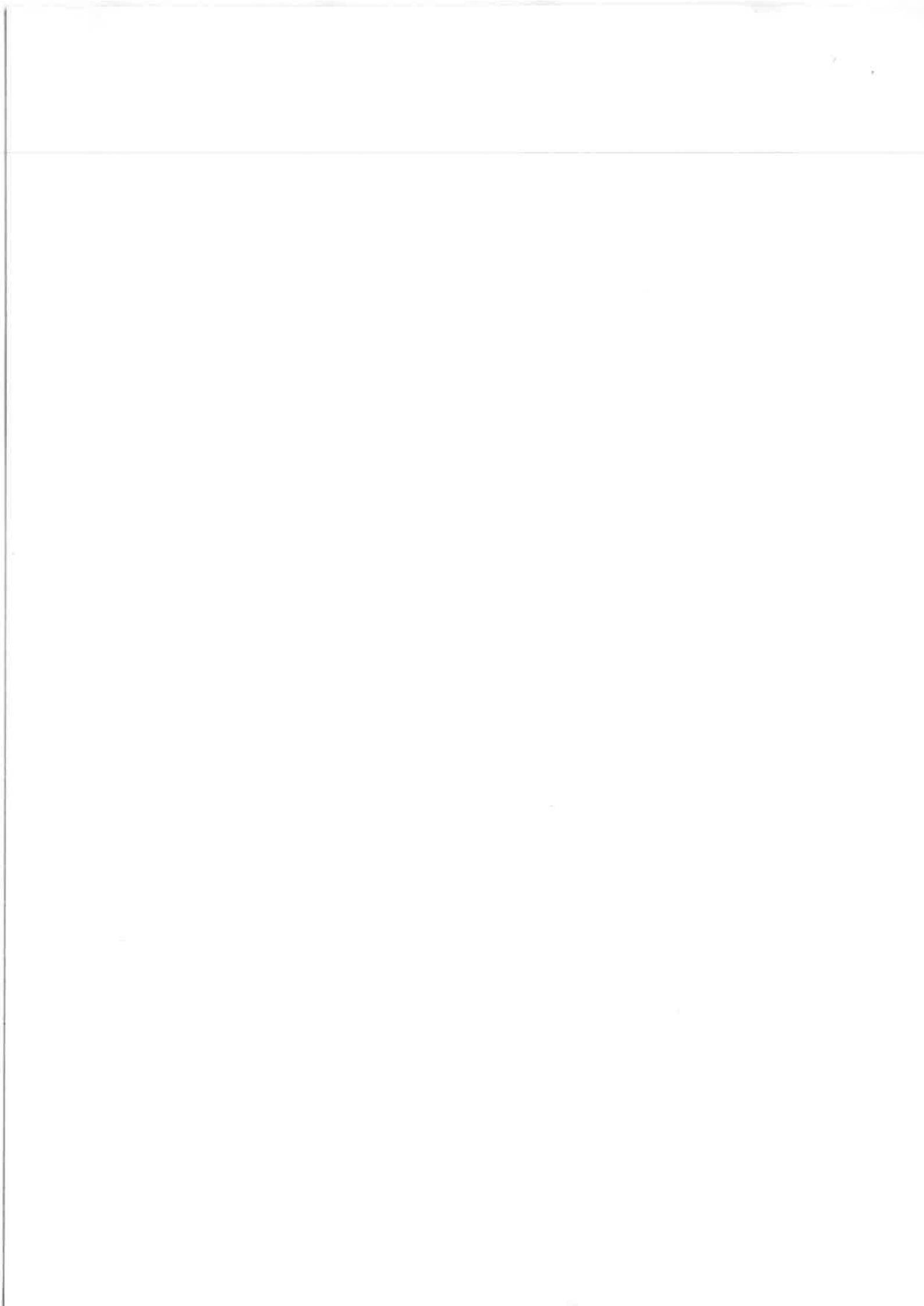

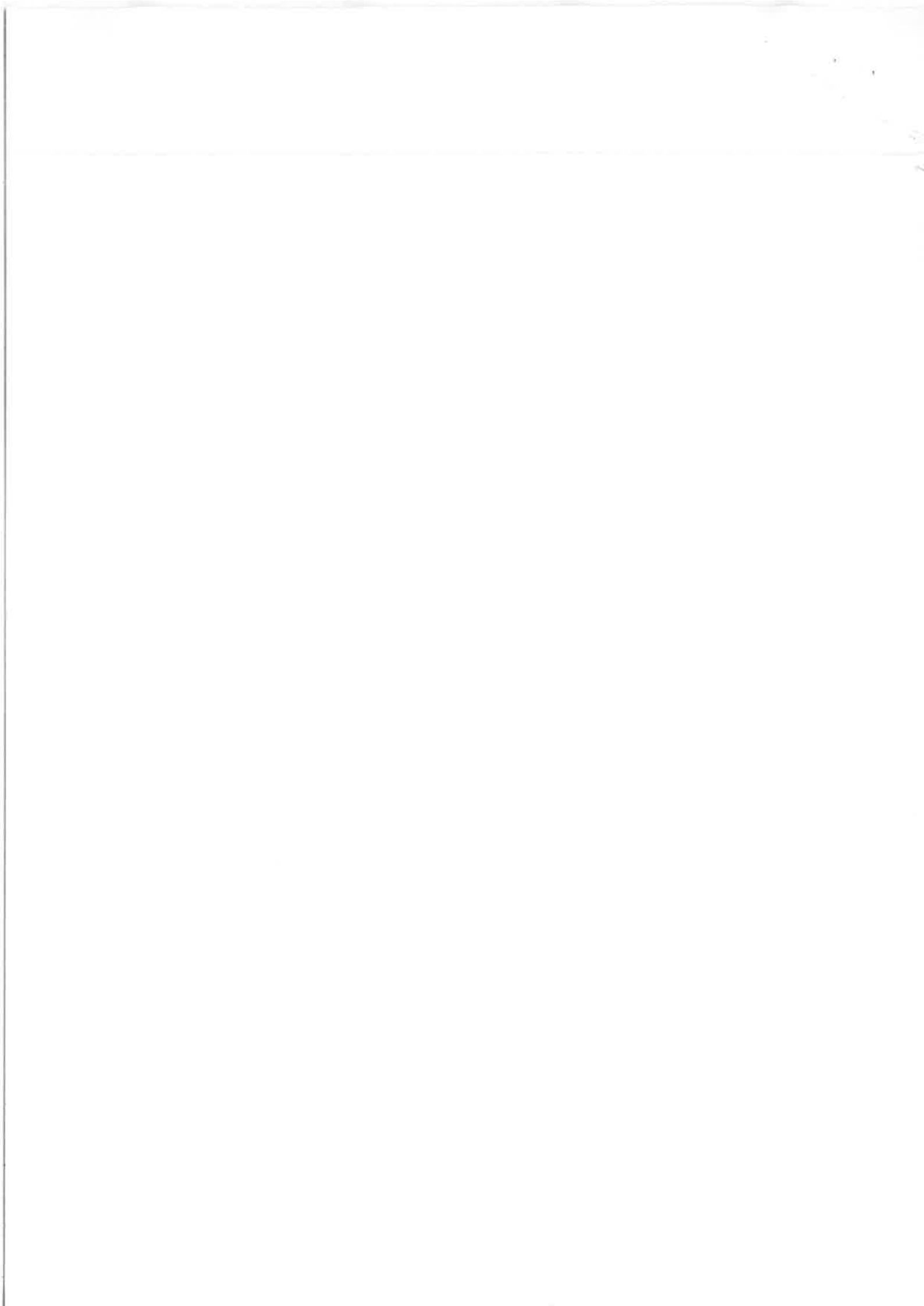
**WHEREAS**, a joint team of officials of CPCB, UPPCB and representative from H.I. Delhi carried out monitoring of the industrial drains in Bulandshahar and Aligarh on 18<sup>th</sup> Feb, 2020; and following observations are made;

1. River Kali East has been identified as potential recipient water body of discharges from M/s Wave Distillery & Breweries Ltd., Ahmadpura, Atrauli, Aligarh (Distillery & Brewery unit).
2. Continuous effluent discharge into river Kali-East through a metal pipe line was observed from the back wall of the unit, M/s Wave Distillery & Breweries Ltd., Ahmadpura, Atrauli, Aligarh, UP.
3. The unit was found discharging its effluent through a pipe line directly into River Kali-East.
4. Water samples collected from upstream (bridge on river kali at Atrauli, Aligarh) and downstream (approx. 2 kms away from the unit) of River Kali- East at Atrauli, Aligarh showed **pH-8.04, Color-26 Hazen, BOD-190 mg/l, COD-640 mg/l, TSS-858mg/l.** and **pH-7.96, color-18 Hazen, BOD-110 mg/l, COD-360 mg/l, TSS-80 mg/l,** respectively.
5. Sample collected from discharge point (unit's pipeline) and from River Kali East at downstream of confluence of discharge point (approx 200 mtrs from the unit's discharge point) showed **pH-7.72, Color-20 Hazen, BOD-130mg/l, COD-440 mg/l, TSS-162 mg/l** and **pH-7.54, Color-16 Hazen, BOD-160mg/l, COD-560 mg/l, TSS-210 mg/l,** respectively.
6. Effluent discharged from the pipe line appeared pale yellow in colour with intense odour.
7. Farmers from the nearby area informed about the continuous discharge of effluent into River Kali during night time.

It is evident that the unit discharges untreated/partially treated effluent from its distillery & brewery operations into river Kali-East, which causes adverse impact on the River water quality. The river Kali-East in this stretch is highly polluted.

**AND NOW, THEREFORE**, in view of the above observations and exercise powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, notice is hereby served to the units to **Show Cause why the Units (M/s Wave Distilleries & Breweries Ltd., (Distillery & Brewery unit)), U.P should not be closed down** until all the necessary pollution control measures are planned and implemented and also to show cause why Environmental Compensation should not be levied.
