Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 – Notice thereof

WHEREAS, the Tannery Industry have been identified as one of the Grossly Polluting Industries (GPI) which have been discharging effluents directly or indirectly on land and into water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on land and the ambient water quality; and

WHEREAS, a team of appointed by Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) officials inspected M/s Tanners Point, Plot No 129 A, Block-C, Ahmad Nagar, Jajmau, Kanpur, UP (herein after referred as the Unit) on 25th May, 2017 to check the compliance of stipulated norms for discharge of effluent and the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures; and

WHEREAS, the inspecting team observed Unit under operation and effluent generated being treated in Primary Effluent Treatment Plant (PETP). The treated effluent collected at the final outlet of PETP has pH-7.54, TSS-72.50 mg/L, **Chromium**- 5.5 mg/L; which is not meeting the prescribed norms for Chromium. Chrome Recovery Plant installed by the unit was observed non-functional and found in damaged condition. Unit is not having consent to operate under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and authorization under Hazardous and other waste (Management and transboundary movement) Rules, 2016 from UPPCB.

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, based on all facts and observations, in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986,

M/s Tanners Point, plot No 129 A, block-C, Ahmad Nagar, Jajmau, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh is hereby directed to close all manufacturing/production activities until it achieves the prescribed standards for effluent discharge and

- 1) The unit obtain consent to operate under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and authorization under Hazardous and other waste (Management and transboundary movement) Rules, 2016 from UPPCB
- 2) Chrome Recovery Plant and PETP be modified to meet the standards for discharge of all parameters notified for the unit
- 3) After completion of the above said measures, the unit shall report to Central Pollution Control Board and seek permission before resumption of any manufacturing operation.

Failure to comply with above directions will attract action in accordance with the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
