Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 – reg.

WHEREAS, Dye & Dye Intermediate units are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, direction under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 was issued on February 05, 2014 to all the State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs) / Pollution Control Committees (PCCs) for installation of online effluent monitoring system w.r.t. pH, TSS, BOD, COD, Cr, & Flow parameters in Dye & Dye Intermediate industries; and

WHEREAS, it was clarified that flow meter & web camera may be installed in case of Units with zero liquid discharge (ZLD) by March 31, 2015 vide guidelines uploaded on website of CPCB dated November 7, 2014; and

WHEREAS, Central Pollution Control Board, Regional Directorate, Vadodara inspected **M/s Devanshi Dyestuff**, Plot No. 141/2 F, GIDC Estate, Ankleshwar, District Bharuch, Gujarat on May 22, 2017 w.r.t. offline status of Online Continuous Effluent Monitoring System and observed that the unit disposes the treated effluent to Narmada Clean Tech Ltd . CETP ; and

WHEREAS, it was observed that the treated effluent is exceeding the Gujarat Pollution Control Board prescribed standards w.r.t. TDS (8964 > 2100 mg/l), COD (608>100 mg/l), BOD (103 >30mg/l), Phenols (1.652 >1.0 mg/l), Sulphate (2189 >1000 mg/l), Fluoride (2.33>1.5 mg/l) thereby inflicting a grave injury to the environment; and

WHEREAS, as per Section 4, Sub section (5) of The Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986; In case where the Central Government is of the opinion that in view of the likelihood of a grave injury to the environment it is not expedient to provide an opportunity to file objections against the proposed direction, it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, issue directions without providing such an opportunity. ; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

NOW, THEREFORE, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, **M/s Devanshi Dyestuff, Plot No. 141/2 F, GIDC Estate, Ankleshwar, District Bharuch, Gujarat** is hereby directed to close down all operational activities with immediate effect until following directions are complied :

1. The unit shall ensure proper maintenance & operation of Effluent treatment plant so that treated effluent conforms to the Gujarat Pollution Control Board prescribed standards.

The time bound action plan for compliance of above directions shall be submitted to Central Pollution Control Board within 15 days of the receipt of the directions. In case of failure to comply with the said directions necessary action as deemed fit under the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 will be taken.
