**DIRECTIONS UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT,
1986**

WHEREAS, central Government has notified standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under Rule 3 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; and

WHEREAS, all industries are required to install and regularly operate the requisite pollution control facilities to comply with the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; and

WHEREAS, Textile dyeing and bleaching industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, M/s. Muskan Dyeing, Nai Basti, Naugawan Sadat, Amroha- 244251 UP (hereafter referred as Unit), it is a textile unit; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued direction dated 12.03.2018 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit to comply with the following directions:

1. The Unit shall resume operation after obtaining valid consent to operate under Water Act and Air Act from Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board and shall treat their effluent to meet the effluent discharge standards as notified under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.
2. The Unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 45 days of resumption of operations
3. The Unit shall ensure continuous connectivity with CPCB server.
4. The Unit shall immediately inform to CPCB regarding the resumption of operations.

AND WHEREAS, the unit reply vide letter dated 23.03.2018 was examined and following observations made:

1. The unit has informed that the unit will resume its manufacturing operations after obtaining consent to operate under Water and Air Acts from UPPCB.
2. The unit will submit treated effluent analysis report within time limit.
3. The unit will ensure that the OCEMS connectivity will continued with CPCB server.

AND WHEREAS, the unit has not complied with the CPCB direction dated 12.03.2018; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued show cause notice dated 01.01.2019 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit; and

WHEREAS, the unit reply vide email dated 25.02.2019 was examined and following observations made:

1. The unit has not resumed operation due to not obtain consent from UPPCB.
2. The unit also informed that the unit is being shifted away from Naugawan village and has applied for consent to UPPCB for the same.

AND WHEREAS, inspection has been carried out by CPCB team on dated 06.03.2019 and following observations were made:

1. The industrial unit was found operational during the visit.
2. As the unit was found operational hence, unit is violating the direction of CPCB.
3. The unit was doing decolourization process by using hydrogen peroxide and waste water was discharged to the adjacent drain outside the unit premises.
4. Samples were collected from the drain and lab analysis report showed complying with pH: 7.05 (against the norms of 6.5-8.5), COD: 167 mg/l (As against the norms of 250 mg/l), TSS: 89 mg/l (against the norms of 100 mg/l) and Phenol: BDL (against the norms of (1mg/l) standards except **BOD: 63 mg/l** (against the norms of 30 mg/l).
5. The unit doesn't have valid consent to operate.
6. There was no electricity supply to the unit at the time of inspection. The unit uses generator for the same.
7. The ETP was found defunct at the time of inspection.
8. OCEMS unit was defunct.
9. As per the unit representative, the unit is shifting from existing place to another place (29°01'47.3"N 78°24'56.2"E) which was visited by the inspection team.

It is evident from the above observation, the Unit misguiding the CPCB and non-complying with the conditions imposed during revocation of earlier closure direction.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and exercising powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the following directions are being issued:

1. The Unit **M/s. Muskan Dyeing, Nai Basti, Naugawan Sadat, Amroha- 244251 UP** shall close down any kind of process at the existing location of the unit with immediate effect.
2. The Unit shall report to CPCB regarding closure of manufacturing operations in compliance of the direction immediately on receipt of this direction.
3. The unit shall not restart or start operation at new location without obtaining consent to operate, installation of OCEMS & connectivity to CPCB and adequate systems to meet prescribed environmental norms.


Failure to comply with above directions will attract action in accordance with the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
