**Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 -reg.**

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed thereunder; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install and operate Effluent Treatment plant (ETP) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the Rules framed thereunder and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCB)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the matter of Paryavaran Suraksha Samiti Vs Union of India & Others dated 22/02/2017 directed that no industry which requires "consent to operate" from the concerned Pollution Control Board, is permitted to function, unless it has a functional effluent treatment plant, which is capable to meet the prescribed norms for removing the pollutants from the effluent, before it is discharged; and

WHEREAS, M/s. Harisons Automobiles, Plot No. 23, Sector 25, Part-1, Panipat (herein after referred as the Unit) is engaged in automobiles servicing & repairing; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected by a joint team of officials from Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) & Haryana State Pollution Control Board (HSPCB) on May 26, 2018 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures; and

WHEREAS, it was observed that Unit was operating without any ETP and was discharging untreated effluent in public sewer; and

WHEREAS, based on the non-compliance observed by the inspecting team, following direction were issued by CPCB to the Unit vide letter no. F.No. -B-23012/1/IPC-III/748 dated August 13, 2018:

1. The Unit shall immediately close down all the operations and shall report to CPCB regarding closure of operations in compliance of the closure direction immediately on the receipt of this direction.
2. The Unit shall obtain valid consent to operate under Water & Air Act from HSPCB.
3. The Unit shall install & commission the required treatment facilities, so as to achieve the standard/ condition prescribed by HSPCB in its consent to operate.
4. The Unit shall provide separate energy meter for ETP operation & shall maintain logbook as per the consent condition.
5. The Unit shall seek permission from CPCB before resumption of the operation.

WHEREAS, the Unit submitted a reply vide letter received on January 28, 2019 that the Unit has complied with all the direction dated August 13, 2018

issued by CPCB, it has closed down the plant operations w.e.f. September 15, 2018 and requested to revoke the closure direction; and

WHEREAS, the Unit also submitted an undertaking for compliance duly notarized, copy of application dated October 29, 2018 for consent to operate, an ETP system adequacy report dated January 11, 2019 from Dept. of Env. Sciences, Central University of Haryana, Mahendergarh, Haryana; and

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 03.10.2017 having representative(s) from CPCB and MoEF&CC for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the three-member committee in its meeting held on March 11, 2019 examined the compliance report submitted by the Unit, recommended that the Unit may be allowed to resume operation with conditions that:

1. The Unit shall start operations only after obtaining the valid consent to operate from the Haryana SPCB.
2. The Unit shall submit performance assessment of the treatment system by analysis of treated effluent by a reputed Government Institution within 60 days of start of operation.

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in exercise of powers vested to Chairman CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and in view of compliance with relevant direction under reference, the direction issued under the Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the Unit (M/s. Harisons Automobiles, Plot No. 23, Sector 25, Part-1, Panipat) vide letter dated August 13, 2018 is hereby revoked with condition that:

1. The Unit shall start operations only after obtaining the valid consent to operate from the Haryana SPCB.
2. The Unit shall submit performance assessment of the treatment system by analysis of treated effluent by a reputed Government Institution within 60 days of start of operation.
3. The Unit shall comply with the effluent & emission norms prescribed in the consent to operate issued by Haryana State Pollution Control Board under the Water Act, 1974 and the Air Act, 1981.

In case of non-compliance by the Unit action as deemed fit under the provisions of Environment (P) Act, 1986 shall be taken.


