Sub.: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986- Reg.

WHEREAS, Chemical units are highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, official of CPCB Regional Directorates, Vadodara inspected the unit on March 13, 2019 under OCEMS surveillance, based on Off-line Status and Following non compliances were observed by inspection team:

- I. The effluent is not meeting the norms w.r.t pH 3.05 (highly acidic) < (5.5- 9.0), BOD -1308 > 100 mg/l and COD 4274 > 250 mg/l prescribed by MPCB.
- II. The unit has discontinued the production of dimethyl amine HCl and instead executing job works for processing intermediate products and solvent recovery without CTO.
- III. The Unit is procuring spent solvent for solvent recovery (i.e. toluene and methanol) through distillation. Unit is not maintaining inventory for receipt and handling of spent solvents from the industry.
- IV. The unit is a member of CETP managed by M/s Lote Parshuram Environment Co-op. Soc., MIDC Lote Parshuram for further treatment and disposal of effluent. The unit has provided online monitoring system for pH and Flow.


WHEREAS, as per Section 4, Sub section (5) of The Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986; In case where the Central Government is of the opinion that in view of the likelihood of a grave injury to the environment it is not expedient to provide an opportunity to file objections against the proposed direction, it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, issue directions without providing such an opportunity; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

NOW THEREORE, in view of the above and in exercise of powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 **M/s Yog Chem Pvt. Ltd., Plot No. E-20, MIDC Lote Parshuram Dist: Ratnagiri, Maharashtra** is hereby directed to close down all manufacturing / production activity until compliance of the following directions are achieved;


1. The unit shall submit ETP adequacy report from any reputed Government institution / organization such as IIT / NIT / CSIR etc. and accordingly upgrade / augment its ETP so that treated effluent conforms to prescribed standards.
2. The unit shall discontinue job works for processing intermediate products and spent solvent recovery activities till the amended CC&A is granted by MPCB for change in process/products/product mix etc.
3. The unit shall collect distillation residue separately and sent to common hazardous waste incineration facility for disposal and unit shall comply with conditions laid down by MPCB in consent to operate.
4. The unit shall ensure uninterrupted OCEMS connectivity with CPCB server.

In case of failure to comply with the said directions necessary action as deemed fit under the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 will be taken by Central Pollution Control Board.
