Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 - reg.

WHEREAS, the Chlor alkali industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the **M/s Grasim Industries Limited, Chemical Division, Rehla, Garhwa Road, Rehla- 822124, Palamu, Jharkhand** (herein after referred as the Unit) was inspected by the team of official(s) from the CPCB Regional Directorate, Kolkata on September 13 & 14, 2018 to investigate the complaint received from Sh. Vishnu Dayal Ram, Hon'ble Member of Parliament, Lok Sabha and following observations made by the inspection team:

1. The Unit discharges RO reject to the drain which meets the Koel River.
2. The Unit has not provided satisfactory information regarding fly ash disposal.
3. The Unit has stored coal and salt in open.
4. The Unit has not provided proper source emission monitoring facilities at HCl stacks A & B.

WHEREAS, based on above stated observations, Directions (notice) under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, was issued to the Unit on January 24, 2019 to show cause as to why all manufacturing/ production activities should not be closed until the above stated observed shortcomings are complied with; and


WHEREAS, the Unit vide letter dated February 11, 2019 informed that they complied with CPCB directions (notice) and requested to revoke the directions dated 05.02.2019; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was re-inspected on March 05, 2019 by the officials from Central Pollution Control Board, Regional Directorate, Kolkata to verify the compliance of CPCB directions (Notice) and observed that the Unit has complied with all the points of CPCB directions; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for

violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and in view of observed compliance by the unit, the directions (notice) issued under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (M/s Grasim Industries Limited, Chemical Division, Rehla, Jharkhand) vide letter dated January 24, 2019 is hereby revoked.




