**Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 - reg.**

**WHEREAS**, Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, M/s Alig Tannery, A-25, LTP, UPSIDC, BANTHAR, Distt. Unnao (UP) (hereafter referred as the Unit), is a tannery engaged in processing of raw hides to wet blue; and

**WHEREAS**, CPCB issued Show-cause notice dated 05.11.2018 under Section-5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit for non-compliance with respect to the revoke directions dated 20.02.2018; and

**WHEREAS**, the unit did not reply/ respond to CPCB regarding the directions dated 20.02.2018 and Show-cause dated 05.11.2018; and

**WHEREAS**, CPCB issued direction dated 02.01.2019 under Section-5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit, to close down all its operations and not to restart till it complies with the following directions and obtain permission from CPCB:

1. The unit shall obtain Hazardous Waste Authorization.
2. The unit shall obtain valid consent to operate from UPPCB and submit a copy of the same to CPCB.
3. The unit shall seek permission from CPCB before resumption of operations after compliance of above directions.

**AND WHEREAS**, the unit reply vide letter dated 25.01.2019, 08.02.2019, 13.02.2019, & 15.02.2019 were examined and following observations are made:

1. A copy of valid Consent to Operate under Water Act, 1974 and Air Act, 1981, both valid till 31.12.2019
2. Unit submitted Self-certificate as per the prescribed format.
3. Unit submitted copy of Authorization issued under the provisions of Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Trans-boundary Movement) Rules, 2016, valid for a period of 31.01.2023.
4. The unit informed that the unit is closed even after revoke direction issued by CPCB dated 20.02.2018.

**AND WHEREAS**, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF&CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

**WHEREAS**, Three Member Committee in meeting held on 11.03.2019 examined the reply and recommended for revoke of closure directions dated 02.01.2019.

**AND NOW THEREFORE**, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Show-cause notice dated 05.11.2018 and direction to close down operations dated 02.01.2019 is hereby revoked and the unit **M/s Alig Tannery, A-25, LTP, UPSIDC, BANTHAR, Distt. Unnao (UP)** is directed to comply with the following:

- (i) The unit shall inform immediately to CPCB on resumption of manufacturing operations.
- (ii) The unit shall ensure regular transmission of data to CPCB server.
- (iii) The unit shall take necessary action to ensure that primary treated effluent discharged, will always comply the PETP standards prescribed by UPPCB / inlet to CETP standards and ensure that PETP effluent is treated in the CETP.
- (iv) The unit shall submit daily analysis result of the treated effluent for one month from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act 1986, within 45 days from the date of resumption of manufacturing operations and submit the implementation report to CPCB.

In case of failure of compliance with the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.


