**Sub: Directions (Notice) under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986-reg.**

WHEREAS, the Fertilizer industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and


WHEREAS, the Unit (**M/s National Fertilizers Limited, Village Vijaipur, Tehsil Raghogarh, District Guna, Madhya Pradesh - 473111**) was inspected by a team of official(s) from the CPCB Regional Directorate, Bhopal on March 18 & 19, 2019 w.r.t. SMS alerts / offline status of Online Continuous Emission / Effluent Monitoring System and made following observations:

1. The unit is not complying with the effluent discharge standard prescribed for Nitrate N ( $14.28 > 10$  mg/l).
2. Hazardous wastes like waste oil, alum and waste poly bags were stored in an area without impervious surface and proper arrangement for spillage collection.
3. The unit has not provided display board showing the quantity of hazardous wastes at the hazardous waste storage area

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.


**NOW, THEREFORE**, based on available facts and observations, in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, you (**M/s National Fertilizers Limited, Village Vijaipur, District Guna, Madhya Pradesh**) are directed to show cause as to why all manufacturing / production activities of your unit should not be closed until the above stated observed shortcomings are complied with.

You are hereby given an opportunity to file your objections (if any) to the above directions within 15 days from the receipt of this notice, failing which action as deemed fit under the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 will be taken by CPCB.
