DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries have been identified as one the Grossly Polluting Industries (GPI) which have been discharging effluents directly or indirectly on land and into water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on land and the ambient water quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the general discharge standards of environment pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environmental (Protection) Rules, 1986;

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications no. S.O. 157(E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and;

WHEREAS, M/s Anupam Processor, B-26, 27 & 28, Industrial area, Partapur, Meerut, Uttar Pradesh (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is involved in the textile, washing, bleaching, drying, dyeing, finishing of grey cloth; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued direction on 09.04.2018 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit for the compliance of the following directions:

1. The unit shall resume operation for a period of one month during which the unit shall stabilize its ETP system.
2. The unit shall inform to CPCB regarding the date of resumption of operation.
3. The unit shall submit its ETP adequacy report from a reputed government institution within 30 days of issuance of direction.
4. The unit shall ensure OCEM connectivity with CPCB server.
5. The unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report from an environmental laboratory recognized under Environment (protection) Act, 1986 within 30 days of issuance of direction to CPCB.

AND WHEREAS, no communication has been received from the unit regarding compliance of above mentioned directions and it is evident that the unit has not complied with CPCB directions dated 09-04-2019; and

M/s Anupam Processor, B-26, 27 & 28, Industrial area, Partapur, Meerut, Uttar Pradesh

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction on 15.10.2018 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit for the compliance; and

WHEREAS, the unit has submitted replies vide letters 19.11.2018, 06.12.2018 and 18.03.2019, following observations are made:

1. The unit has informed dated 19.11.2018 to CPCB that it has not resumed operation.
2. The unit has been inspected by CPCB dated 01.01.2019 and found unit was non-operational, ETP was found to be under construction, there were many small open channels found which were directly connected to the main channel of waste water (Outlet) and unit has not install flow meter at borewell.
3. CPCB issued a letter dated 25.01.2019 for submission of adequacy report of ETP prepared by reputed government institution, self-certificate of closure in the prescribed format and proof of closure of all open channels connected ETP outlet.
4. The unit has submitted on dated 18.03.2019, adequacy of modified existing effluent treatment plant for treatment of effluent to be generated from processing of 15000 m grey cloth per day from CPPRI, Saharanpur and found the ETP system is adequate. Also submitted effluent analysis report by the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 recognized laboratory.
5. The unit has informed completion of upgradation of ETP system which is verified from CPPRI.
6. The unit has submitted proof of closure of all open channels connected ETP outlet.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF &CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, Three-member committee in its meeting held on 11.04.2019 examined the reply of the Unit and recommended for revocation with direction that:

1. The unit is recommended for operational for 60 days.
2. Same government institute will inspect the unit for compliance verification within 60 days.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the following directions are being issued:

1. The unit **M/s Anupam Processor, B-26, 27 & 28, Industrial area, Partapur, Meerut, Uttar Pradesh** shall start its manufacturing operation for 60 days.
2. The unit shall report to CPCB regarding start of manufacturing operations.
3. The unit shall submit performance assessment of the treatment system including analysis of treated effluent by the same reputed government institute within 60 days.

Failure to comply with above directions will attract action in accordance with the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
